

Table 3 below shows the average daily balances in the Motor License Fund for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's fiscal years 2013 through 2022. This table includes all sources of revenue (both restricted and unrestricted) for the Motor License Fund and not just the sources of revenue that are considered available under Act 44 for debt service payments on the Special Revenue Bonds.
