The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Mauritius to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Office for Disarmament Affairs of the United Nations and with reference to its four Notes dated 5 February 2010 regarding implementation of resolutions 63/57, 64/40, 64/54 and 64/22, has the honour to forward the views of the Government of Mauritius hereunder:

## (i) Resolution 63/57

The issue of confidence-building measures is pertinent to those situations where there are two or more conflicting parties and where the need for the exchange of information on military maneuvers and verification of armaments arise. However since Mauritius does not have any military force, there is no information on confidence-building measures.
