

REPUBLIC OF SERBIA: INFORMATION PURSUANT TO OPERATIVE PARAGRAPH 2 OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY  
RESOLUTION 63/57, ENTITLED "INFORMATION ON CONFIDENCE-BUILDING MEASURES IN THE FIELD OF  
CONVENTIONAL ARMS"

The Republic of Serbia implements consistently the provisions of international agreements in the field of conventional arms control. To that end, it abides fully by its obligations towards the OSCE by complying with the below-listed documents:

- 1999 Vienna Document, including voluntary bilateral cooperation in the regional and sub-regional context with Hungary, Bulgaria and Germany;
- Agreement on the Subregional Arms Control (Article IV, Annex 1-B, of the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina); and
- Global Exchange of Military Information.

Serbia also fully complies with its obligations under UNGA resolutions. All necessary measures are taken to ensure transparency of conventional arms transfers. Regular reports on the export and import of 7 categories of arms covered by the Register are submitted to the United Nations Register of Conventional Arms. Serbia has accepted the principles of the EU Code of Conduct regarding the export of arms and military equipment and a procedure to accede to international control regimes in this area is underway. Of particular importance is the Wassenaar Arrangement which is to provide a database on export licenses of the Parties to the Arrangement.
