Resolution 67/49: Information on Confidence Building Measures in the Field of Conventional Arms

Being a full member of the Vienna Document 2011, Montenegro actively participates in confidence building measures in the field of conventional arms in Europe. During last year 3 inspections of the specific areas and one evaluation (Estonia, USA, Belgium and Greece) were carried out, while Montenegro carried out 2 inspections of specific areas (FYROM, Albania), as well as two evaluation projects in the Federal Republic of Germany and Hungary, under auspices of bilateral agreements.

All activities concerning inspection fully presented exact conditions which were reported through Annual Information exchanged with all member-states of BD11. States that carried out the inspections confirmed the exactness of information and reported about that to all OSCE member-states through OSCE Communication Network.

Moreover, Montenegro also exchanged the Annual Information about global military information.

Montenegro has made Strategy with the following Action Plan for the control and reduction of SALW. Those efforts were wholeheartedly supported by UNDP and OSCE, as well as the UN, American and German Embassy in Montenegro. After the adoption of the Strategy and Action Plan, realization of planned activities will significantly contribute to the general security of the Region and beyond.

Under auspices of the UN conventions on disarmament (CCW, CWC, Ottawa Convention, CCM) Montenegro openly exchanges information through Annual Reports. In addition, as a new member-state of Amended Protocol II of the CCW an Annual Report was delivered to the UN.
