<p><b>Complex Incident Management (CIM) Training:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2023 Qualification sheets are complete.</li> <li>• Mid-Term (2024-2026):               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Basic Type 3 training; S-420 Command and General Staff, L-481 Advanced Leadership for Command and General Staff, and O-305 Operations Section Chief Type 3.</li> <li>○ Will need to fill in experience gap once CIM is implemented.</li> <li>○ Mentoring could also be a component of the new course.</li> <li>○ Type 3 courses will help develop teams earlier by establishing qualifications at the Type 3 level.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• S-520, Advanced Incident Management:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Offered very infrequently, new course should be taught geographically to meet the demands.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Incident Position and Training Modernization (IPTM) will affect long term CIM training.</li> <li>• Changes from 2022 to 2023:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ CIM Qualification Sheets.</li> <li>○ Turned off Type 2 pathway.</li> <li>○ NMAC increased the number of trainees allowed on teams.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• The NWCG standard will be CIM but ultimately agencies and states will have the discretion to adopt CIM.</li> </ul>	<p>Incident Position and Standards Committee (IPSC) is currently vetting within agencies.
