Arizona Department of Gaming Releases December Sports Betting Figures

PHOENIX – Bettors in Arizona wagered over \$572 million in December of 2022, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents a 14.7% increase when compared to December of 2021.

"December of 2022 was another strong month for Arizona sports betting, with over \$73 million more dollars wagered when compared to the same month of 2021," said Jackie Johnson, Director, ADG. "This caps off a stellar first full calendar year of sports betting for the state, with over \$6 billion wagered throughout 2022."

Privilege fees totaled over \$3.7 million in the month, resulting in nearly \$35 million in privilege fees collected by the state since the start of legal operations. You can view the full December event wagering report on the ADG website: <u>LINK</u>.
