## Arizona Department of Gaming Releases January Sports Betting & Fantasy Sports Figures

PHOENIX – Bettors in Arizona wagered over \$591 million on sports in January of 2023, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming.

"We saw another substantial month of sports betting in Arizona to kick off 2023, with nearly \$600 million wagered during January," said Jackie Johnson, Director, ADG. "I look forward to monitoring how wagering progresses throughout the rest of the year."

Event wagering privilege fees totaled over \$2.8 million in the month, resulting in over \$37 million in privilege fees collected by the state since the start of legal operations. Fantasy sports also had a strong month, with a new record of approximately \$8.8 million in collected in-state entry fees and over \$80 thousand in privilege fees collected by the state.
