## May Event Wagering Sees a Record Level of Privilege Fees to State

PHOENIX – Arizona event wagering figures continued to look strong during the month of May. According to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming, the state saw a record \$4.1 million in privilege fees during the month.

"The newly emerging event wagering industry in Arizona continues to impress, with over \$460 million wagered and over \$4 million in privilege fees in the month of May," said Ted Vogt, Director, ADG. "Since the start of legal event wagering, we have seen approximately \$30 million in privilege and licensing fees contributed to the state."
