REGULATIONS:

- (1) Application for acceptance into the program should be made by the beginning of the senior year.
- (2) A student may enroll in the program if s/he has a grade-point average of 3.5 or higher on all work completed at the University and an average of 3.5 in courses taken in the Geography Department. Please attach an unofficial transcript.
- (3) Credit for H195A or H195B in a single semester may aggregate no more than four units; A senior in the Honors Program must complete Geography H195A and/or H195B consecutively, in which a thesis is required (usually over two semesters).
- (5) Honors with the Bachelor's degree are of three kinds: Honors, High Honors, and Highest Honors. The level of honors to be awarded is determined by the Department. A student may not graduate with honors unless he has an overall grade-point average of 3.5 or higher on his/her record in the University at time of graduation.
- (6) Students who have received an "I" in any portion of the honors program, and who have not converted the "I" grade to a final grade before they graduate, will not receive honors at the time of graduation.
