Enhanced Driver's License Examples:

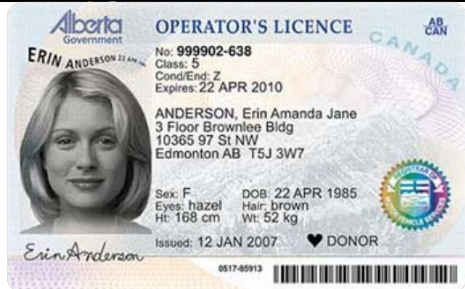
5 States offer an enhanced driver's license. All say "Enhanced" on the top, except New York who has an American flag on the bottom right.

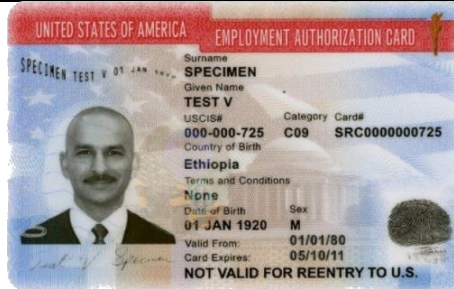

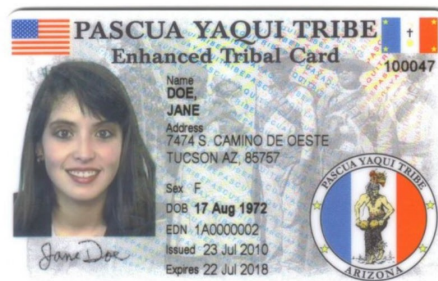

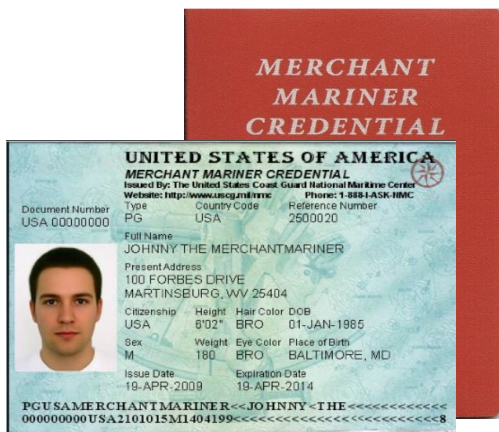
