





To confirm, or not, the Temp Spec as Consensus Policy by 25 May 2019 Develop Policy Recs and answer 52 Charter Questions





High-Level Overview of Final Report

Final Report contains 29 Policy Recommendations:

- Purposes for Processing Data (Rec #1)
- Details on the collection and transfer of specifically identified data elements (Rec #5, 7, 8, 9)
- Display and redaction of specifically identified data elements (Rec #10-12)
- Refer to the treatment of current ICANN Consensus Policies (Rec #21 25, 27)
- A proposed implementation bridge (Rec #28)
- Items to be further discussed during Phase 2 of the EPDP Team's work (Rec #2, 3, 15, 17, 18)

All of the recommendations received full consensus / consensus support of the EPDP Team, apart from 2 recommendations (#2 – additional purposes and #16 – geographic basis)


