



Expedited PDP on the Temporary Specification Phase 2

- Focus on phase 2 topics, particularly System for Standardized Access/Disclosure to non-public registration data
- Target date for Initial Report shortly after ICANN66

New gTLD Subsequent Procedures

- Considering the changes that may be necessary to the existing policy recommendations and implementation (i.e., Applicant Guidebook) for new gTLDs
- Target date for Final Report Q4 of 2019

Review of All Rights Protection Mechanisms (RPMs) in All gTLDs

- Consideration of the current state and possible revision of all gTLD RPMs
- Target date for Phase 1 Initial Report Q2 of 2020

Name Collision Analysis Project (NCAP)

- NCAP Discussion Group (NCAP WP plus community) formed as of 24 April and meeting weekly, currently 20 participants, 22 observers
- Discussion Group finalized the Statement of Work for Study One and sent to Office of OCTO on 30 May.
- Next Steps: OCTO start an open RFP process to engage a contractor
- Discussion Group preparing a second deliverable: definition of name collisions, to be ready for public comment after ICANN65.
