SMWBE Program "Local"

- Small Business Enterprise (SBE)
- Minority Business Enterprise (MBE)
- Women Business Enterprise (WBE)
- Veteran Business Enterprise (VBE)
- African American Business Enterprise (AABE)
- Asian American Business Enterprise (ABE)
- Disabled Individual Business Enterprise (DIBE)

*To be considered eligible for any of the certifications, a firm must be independent and for-profit owned by a majority of U.S. Citizens or legally permanent residents.

*A business structure for-profit small business concerns where socially and economically disadvantaged individuals own at least 51% interest and also control management and daily business operations


