HB 3271 (87thR) provides authorization for the Texas Economic Development and Tourism office to develop and administer the State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI). March 11, 2021, the US Congress enacted the American Rescue Plan Act, which, in part, provides \$10 billion to fund the State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI 2.0) administered by the US Department of Treasury (Treasury). This initiative is the second installment from the previous program passed under the Small Business Jobs Act of 2010 (SSBCI 1.0) which was almost \$1.5 billion. The objective of the program is to provide resources to support small businesses that have traditionally been marginalized and that have been impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic. Under SSBCI 2.0, Texas' total allocation of funds are almost \$472 million, about ten times more than the \$46.8 million allocated to to the Texas Department of Agriculture under SSBCI 1.0.
