

We hope that this zero-draft could serve as a basis for moving forward.

We would like to invite you to the next informal consultations, on Thursday, 28 March 2024 at 10:00 a.m. in Conference Room 4, where we look forward to introducing the zero-draft. We encourage Member States to come prepared to express their views on the zero-draft resolutions during a first reading. As previously indicated, interpretation will be on an “as available” basis.
