



DISMISSAL OF ACCUSATION

The Executive Director of the Alaska State Commission for Human Rights (“ASCHR”) filed the Accusation in this matter on July 25, 2018. The case was referred to this tribunal for a hearing under AS 18.80.120, and has since been repeatedly stayed by agreement of the parties while settlement negotiations proceeded.

The Executive Director now elects to voluntarily DISMISS the accusation, without prejudice. The substantial evidence determinations made pursuant to AS 18.80.110 on March 30, 2018 (Respondent Price Gregory Int’l) and April 6, 2018 (Beacon Occupation Health and Safety Services) remain in effect. Dismissal of the Accusation returns this matter to the conciliation phase. The Executive Director intends to enter a Conciliation Agreement with the Respondents pursuant to AS 18.80.110 and AS 18.80.112(b).
