- Kennels available for pets
- Lockers for smaller items & secured compartments for larger items while receiving services.

- Case management services and referrals to other partner agencies for support services.
- Assistance with obtaining government ID, applying for MedQuest & other eligible welfare benefits

HOUSE RULES:

- NO violence, threats, verbal abuse, weapons, illegal drugs, alcohol, paraphernalia
- NO smoking outside of designated areas
- NO vandalism, destruction of property, littering
- NO loitering, panhandling, buying or selling of goods/services
- NO harassment or sexual activity
- NO photography or video recording of clients & staff
- Be kind and considerate of other residents and staff
- Must sleep on site. If gone for more than 24 hours, bed will no longer be secured.
- Pets must be under control at all times.
- One person at a time in the showers/restrooms
- All cars must remain parked during quiet hours.
