**JULY 10<sup>th</sup> ROCHESTER (11-2)/(49-37) at WORCESTER (6-6)/(41-46) 12:15 pm**

**Rochester Red Wings RHP Thaddeus Ward (4-3, 6.12) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Brad Keller (1-1, 8.44)**

**Hot Topic** – The Worcester Red Sox and the 1<sup>st</sup>-place Rochester Red Wings (AAA-Washington Nationals) play game two of their 6-game series at sultry Polar Park this afternoon at 12:15 pm as the WooSox look to even this series at a victory apiece following Rochester's 5-1 victory in the opener last night. Today's game is live on NESN and can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

**This Series** - This series marks the continuation of Worcester's 9-game homestand (1-3 thus far) that began last week with the Sox dropping 2 of 3 to Syracuse. The Red Sox and Red Wings are meeting for the second time this season here at Polar Park (the clubs split a 6-game set from June 4-9). Rochester got the jump in this 6-game series with their 5-1 victory last night as the Wings broke open a close game with a 3-run top of the 9<sup>th</sup>—inning to win for the 11<sup>th</sup> time in 13 games to begin the second half of the season. After today's matinee, the clubs will meet tomorrow & Friday both at 6:45 pm, Saturday at 4:05 pm, and Sunday at 1:05 pm in the final game before the All-Star break (from July 15-18).

**Daydream Believers** – This afternoon is Worcester's penultimate weekday matinee of the season at Polar Park (their final such game will be on Thursday, August 1 vs. Buffalo at 12:15 pm). Worcester has had more success this season in day games (21-19) than at night (20-27).

**Wingstop** – The Red Wings currently own the best record in the league in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half at 11-2 and lead the 5<sup>th</sup>-place WooSox (6-6) by 4½ games. The clubs have played seven games against each other (all here at Polar Park) with Rochester holding a 4 games to 3 advantage. Worcester will finally make their first and only trip to Rochester all season from September 2-8 for a 6-game set vs. the Red Wings.

**This Season vs. Rochester** – The first six games between Worcester and Rochester from June 4-9 were high-scoring affairs (at least for the winning team). Rochester won the first two games by 11-4 and 9-6 scores, the WooSox won the next three in a row, 13-4, 7-4, and 8-2, and the Red Wings gained the split with an 8-5 victory in the finale just over a month ago on June 9. Rochester's 5-1 victory last night means the WooSox have now out-scored the Red Wings, 44-43 in the seven games combined.

**Stats vs. the Wings** – Worcester is 3-4 vs. Rochester this season. Sox batters are hitting .282 (67-for-238) with 10 HR vs. the Red Wings while WooSox pitchers have posted a 4.57 ERA (32 ER in 63 IP) with 11 HRA.

**Worcester/Pawtucket vs. Rochester**– Worcester and Rochester are dead even at 37 wins apiece in the all-time series against each other (since 2021). The Red Wings are 25-17 all-time at Polar Park while the WooSox are 20-12 in Rochester winning 19 of their last 26 games at the Rock. Furthermore, Worcester is just one game up on Rochester with 361 wins to 360 in the remarkably close last 44½ years of facing each other since the 1979 season. These two clubs went 12-12 during their season-series against each other last year as the teams finished 6-6 here at Polar Park and 6-6 in Rochester as well.

***No Offense*** – After averaging 8.25 runs/game (66 runs in 8 games) while going 5-3 during their past recent roadtrip (June 25 – July 3), the WooSox have returned home and scored a total of 8 runs in their four games thus far (9-1 4-2, and 5-1 defeats and a 4-0 win). Worcester's Team Batting Average reached a season-high .263 on July 3 to lead the International League, but the Sox average is now down to .260 (7<sup>th</sup> in the league). On the season, the WooSox are hitting better at home with a .264 average (388-for-1471) with 61 HR compared to .255 on the road (346-for-1355) with 48 HR.

***Leading the Way*** – The above said, Worcester is still 1<sup>st</sup> in on-base pct. among all 20 International League clubs with their .370 on-base pct. The Sox are also tops in the league with 449 walks (most in all of Triple-A in fact) and they are 2<sup>nd</sup> with 63 hit batsmen (Buffalo has 65 HB). It all adds up to an impressive .370 OBP. Furthermore, the WooSox are 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league with 497 runs scored behind only Norfolk (511 runs).

***Second Half Adjustments*** – The WooSox are 6-6 to begin the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the season (the final 75 games from June 25 through September 22). Worcester went 35-40 during the 1<sup>st</sup> half good for 7<sup>th</sup>-place in the IL East and 11½-games in back of division champ Syracuse who went 46-28 and won the division. However, Omaha from the IL West had the best overall record in the first half and the Storm Chasers earned the one playoff spot as first half champs.

***July Underway*** – Worcester is 3-4 in July. They are batting .258 (61-for-236) with 10 HR along with a 4.06 ERA (28 ER in 62 IP this month while out-scoring the opposition, 35-33). The Sox are in the midst of playing 18 of 27 games on the road between June 25 and July 28. Starting July 30<sup>th</sup>, the WooSox will play 18 of 30 games at Polar Park through September 1.

***June Over*** – The WooSox finished 12-13 in June. The team batted .284 in June with 30 HR – their best month of the year and the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest average in the league in June. Sox pitchers had a 4.99 ERA during the month with 26 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 160-137 in June. Worcester went 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, and 14-14 in May.

***Home Goods*** – Worcester is back below the .500 mark at Polar Park this year with their 22-23 record in Worcester (compared to 19-23 away from home). The Sox have been up and down at Polar Park throughout this season. They started 1-4 at home from April 2-7, then went 14-5 at Polar Park from April 16 – May 21, were recently 0-7 from May 22 – June 5, then went 3-0 from June 6-8, before currently going 4-7 in their last 11 games at home.

***One is a Lonely Number*** – The WooSox are 3-12 in 1-run games this season (the worst mark in the league). Every other IL club has at least six 1-run wins while Rochester is 13-6 in 1-run games on the year. All three WooSox 1-run wins this season have come against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, May 16 (13-12) and May 17 (9-8) both at home vs. the RailRiders, and June 25 (6-5) in Moosic, PA. Worcester is 7-11 in 2-run games this season. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games and they were 13-10 in 2-run affairs.

**Five Below** – The WooSox are 41-46 overall. Three times this season (all in June), Worcester had fallen to a season and franchise-low 7-games under .500. Those dates came most recently on June 14 (30-37) as well as on June 12 at 29-36 and on June 5 at 26-33. Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

**Left at the Altar** – Worcester is 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league with 685 runners left on base this season. Gwinnett is 1<sup>st</sup> with 688 LOB.

**Hit Me With Your Best Shot** – WooSox batters are 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 63 times this season. The Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) in a season is 79 set by the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

**Rankings** – Worcester is 7<sup>th</sup> in the IL in team batting with a .260 average while Rochester is 11<sup>th</sup> at .259. On the pitching side, the Sox are 10<sup>th</sup> in team ERA (4.98) while the Red Wings are 19<sup>th</sup> with a 5.38 ERA.

**Streaks** – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

**Series Math** – Worcester is 6-6-4 in their first 16 series of 2024 (6 wins, 6 losses, and 4 splits). Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

**Comebacks and Last AB** – Worcester has 18 come-from-behind victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off. They have suffered 11 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

**May Be or Might Be** - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

**April Recap** - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers).

**A Winning Tradition** – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

**Finish Line** – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7<sup>th</sup>-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1<sup>st</sup> half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half.

**You Need a Scorecard** – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

**Two Dozen to Go** - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

**PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE** – The Portland Sea Dogs (8-3)/(44-36) won at Hartford last night, 7-3. Hunter Dobbins improved to 6-2 with 6 shutout innings – 6 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 6 SO. Philip Sikes went 2-for-4 with a 2-run HR (#5) and was one of five Sea Dogs with 2 hits apiece. Kristian Campbell ripped 2 doubles and scored 3 runs, Eddinson Paulino had a single, double, 2 RBI, and scored a run; Blaze Jordan was 2-for-5 with 2 RBI and a run scored; and Kyle Teel added 2 hits and 1 run.

**WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES** – The WooSox today added both LHP **Cam Booser** and INF **Enmanuel Valdez**, who were optioned from Boston on Monday and Tuesday respectively, to their roster. The WooSox also placed C **Mark Kolozsvary** back on the development list.

On Monday the Boston Red Sox optioned left-handed pitcher **Cam Booser** to Worcester. Booser, 32, has posted a 3.00 ERA (10 ER/30.0 IP) with 34 strikeouts in 27 games for Boston this season, allowing zero runs in his last nine outings. The left-hander has also pitched in six games for the WooSox going 2-2 with a 7.00 ERA in 6 relief appearances allowing seven runs in 9.0 innings with 18 strikeouts and only one walk. The Washington state native was signed by Boston as a minor league free agent on February 6, 2023.

On Tuesday, the Red Sox optioned INF **Enmanuel Valdez** to Worcester. Valdez 25, has played in 56 games for Boston this season, making 45 starts at second base and one as the designated hitter while batting .226 (37-for-164) with six home runs and 26 RBI. The left-handed hitter has also played in 20 games for Worcester, batting .230 (17-for-74) with six home runs and 10 RBI. Originally signed by the Houston Astros as an international free agent in July 2015, the Dominican Republic native has batted .244 (74-for-303) with a .721 OPS, 12 home runs, and 45 RBI in 105 games with the Red Sox (2023-24).

Worcester has already used 61 players this season (27 position players and 34 pitchers).

The WooSox have sent 15 players to Boston since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, INF/OF Jamie Westbrook, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Isaiah Campbell, and LHP Bailey Horn. Those 15 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O'Neill, OF Masataka Yoshida, RHP Chris Martin, and OF Wilyer Abreu who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa (DFA), Criswell, Dalbec, Heineman, Campbell, Booser, and Valdez are back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
