Rochester Red Wings RHP Luis Reyes (2-2, 6.50) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Justin Hagenman (1-3, 4.94)

Go With the Flo – With Worcester Red Sox manager Chad Tracy on a mandated three-day break before the All-Star break (per Boston Red Sox Minor League staff policy), the WooSox turn over their reigns to loyal bench coach Jose David Flores as Flo will be acting manager this weekend for the final three games of this series vs. Rochester beginning tonight. The WooSox – who trail this 6-game set, 2 games to 1 - bid to even matters when they play game four tonight against the 1^{st} -place Rochester Red Wings (AAA-Washington Nationals) at 6:45 pm at Polar Park. This evening's game, which will be followed by UniBank Fireworks, can be seen live on NESN+ and heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

Flo Bio - Jose David Flores was hired as the bench coach of the WooSox on December 13, 2021 and is in his third season in that role in 2024. Flores has more than 20 years of experience as a coach or manager. Before coming to Worcester, he spent the 2019 & 2020 seasons as the third base coach for the Baltimore Orioles. Prior to that he spent one season as the first base coach for the Philadelphia Phillies in 2018 under Gabe Kapler. He also served as the infield coach for both the Orioles and Phillies during those years. Before joining the major league ranks, Flores served as the Chicago Cubs' Minor League infield coordinator from 2013-17.

A native of Puerto Rico, Jose managed the Puerto Rico National Team from 2011-12 during the PanAm Games and Baseball World Cup, then served on the coaching staff for Team Puerto Rico in the 2013 World Baseball Classic. From 2004-11, he managed the Cidra Bravos of the Puerto Rico Baseball Federation, where he won four national titles and was named 2005 Manager of the Year.

Selected by the Houston Astros in the 1990 First-Year Player Draft, Flores spent his entire professional playing career as an infielder in Houston's minor league system from 1990-94. A slick-fielding, switch-hitting middle infielder, Jose reached Double-A Jackson of the former Texas League in 1994.

Flores lives in Gurabo, Puerto Rico during the off-season with his wife Luz (Lisa) and the couple's two daughters Adrianna and Allison.

This Series & Homestand – Rochester retook the lead in this series thanks to their 6-3 victory last night. The Red Wings won the series-opener on Tuesday, 5-1. Worcester's victory thus far game in the middle game on Wednesday, 7-6 in a see-saw affair. The WooSox are in the midst of a 9-game homestand (2-4 thus far) that began last week with the Sox dropping 2 of 3 to Syracuse. The Red Sox and Red Wings are meeting for the second time this season here at Polar Park (the clubs split a 6-game set from June 4-9). After tonight, the teams will meet tomorrow at 4:05 pm and then Sunday at 1:05 pm in the final game before the All-Star break (Monday – Thursday next week from July 15-18).

What Have You Done For Me Lately – The WooSox won three straight from June 30 – July 2 and then lost three in a row from July 3-5. Since then they have gone...win, loss, win, loss between July 6-11.

Wingstop – The Red Wings currently own the best record in the league in the 2^{nd} half at 12-3 and lead the 5th-place WooSox (7-7) by $4\frac{1}{2}$ games. The clubs have played 9 games against each other (all here at Polar Park) this season and Rochester leads, 5 games to 4. Worcester will finally make their first and only trip to Rochester all season from September 2-8 for another 6-game set vs. the Wings.

This Season vs. Rochester – The first six games between Worcester and Rochester from June 4-9 were high-scoring affairs (at least for the winning team). Rochester won the first two games by 11-4 and 9-6 scores, the WooSox won the next three in a row, 13-4, 7-4, and 8-2, and the Red Wings gained the split with an 8-5 victory in the finale just over a month ago on June 9. Rochester's 5-1 and 6-3 victories this week around a 7-6 Sox win means the Red Wings have now out-scored the WooSox, 55-54 in the 9 games combined.

Stats vs. the Wings – Worcester is 4-5 vs. Rochester this season. Sox batters are hitting .262 (78-for-298) with 14 HR vs. the Red Wings while WooSox pitchers have posted a 4.89 ERA (44 ER in 81 IP) with 14 HRA.

Worcester/Pawtucket vs. Rochester– Worcester and Rochester are tied 38-38 in the all-time series against each other (since 2021). The Red Wings are 26-18 all-time at Polar Park while the WooSox are 20-12 in Rochester winning 19 of their last 26 games at the Rock. Furthermore, Worcester is just one game up on Rochester with 362 wins to 361 in the remarkably close last 44½ years of facing each other since the 1979 season. These two clubs went 12-12 during their season-series against each other last year as the teams finished 6-6 here at Polar Park and 6-6 in Rochester as well.

Leading the Way – Worcester is 1^{st} in on-base pct. among all 20 International League clubs with their .369 on-base pct. The Sox are also tops in the league with 457 walks (most in all of Triple-A in fact) and they are 2^{nd} with 64 hit batsmen (Buffalo has 65 HB). It all adds up to an impressive .369 OBP. Furthermore, the WooSox are 2^{nd} in the league with 507 runs scored behind only Norfolk (517).

Second Half Adjustments – The WooSox are 7-7 to begin the 2^{nd} half of the season (the final 75 games from June 25 through September 22). Worcester went 35-40 during the 1^{st} half good for 7^{th} -place in the IL East and $11\frac{1}{2}$ -games in back of division champ Syracuse who went 46-28 and won the division. However, Omaha from the IL West had the best overall record in the first half and the Storm Chasers earned the one playoff spot as first half champs.

One to Remember – The WooSox came out on top in a 1-run decision on Wednesday, 7-6 for only the fourth time all season. They are 4-12 in 1-run games this season (the worst mark in the league). Every other IL club has at least six 1-run wins while Rochester is 13-7 in 1-run games on the year. The first three WooSox 1-run wins this year came against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on May 16 (13-12) and May 17 (9-8) both at home vs. the RailRiders and June 25 (6-5) in Moosic, PA. Worcester is 7-11 in 2-run games this season. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games and they were 13-10 in 2-run affairs.

July Underway – Worcester is 4-5 in July. They are batting .243 (72-for-296) with 14 HR along with a 4.50 ERA (40 ER in 80 IP) this month while tied in scoring with the opposition, 45-45. The Sox are in the midst of playing 18 of 27 games on the road between June 25 and July 28. Starting July 30th, the WooSox will play 18 of 30 games at Polar Park through September 1.

June Over – The WooSox finished 12-13 in June. The team batted .284 in June with 30 HR – their best month of the year and the 3^{rd} highest average in the league in June. Sox pitchers had a 4.99 ERA during the month with 26 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 160-137 in June. Worcester went 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, and 14-14 in May.

Home Goods – Worcester is back below the .500 mark at Polar Park this year with their 23-24 record in Worcester (compared to 19-23 away from home). The Sox have been up and down at Polar Park throughout this season. They started 1-4 at home from April 2-7, then went 14-5 at Polar Park from April 16 – May 21, were recently 0-7 from May 22 – June 5, then went 3-0 from June 6-8, before currently going 5-8 in their last 13 games at home.

Five Below – The WooSox are 42-47 overall. Three times this season (all in June), Worcester had fallen to a season and franchise-low 7-games under .500. Those dates came most recently on June 14 (30-37) as well as on June 12 at 29-36 and on June 5 at 26-33. Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

Left at the Altar – Worcester is 2nd in the league with 693 runners left on base this season. Gwinnett is 1st with 713 LOB.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – WooSox batters are 2^{nd} in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 64 times this season. The Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) in a season is 79 set by the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

Rankings – Worcester is 9^{th} in the IL in team batting with a .258 average while Rochester is 7^{th} at .260. On the pitching side, the Sox are 10^{th} in team ERA (5.00) while the Red Wings are 19^{th} with a 5.35 ERA.

Daydream Believers - Worcester has had more success this season in day games (22-19) than at night (20-28).

Streaks – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

Series Math – Worcester is 6-6-4 in their first 16 series of 2024 (6 wins, 6 losses, and 4 splits). Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Comebacks and Last AB – Worcester has 19 come-from-behind victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off. They have suffered 11 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

May Be or Might Be - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers).

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2^{nd} half.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (9-4)/(45-37) rolled to a 10-1 win at Hartford last night. Eddinson Paulino ripped 3 hits good for 2 RBI and 2 runs scored while Nick Decker drilled 3 doubles. Elih Marrero added 2 hits and scored 2 runs while Alex Binelas belted a 2-run triple. Robert Kwiatkowski improved to 8-2 with 2 scoreless innings of relief for the victory.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None as of early-afternoon, but stay close by. Worcester has already used 61 players this season (27 position players and 34 pitchers).

The WooSox have sent 15 players to Boston since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, INF/OF Jamie Westbrook, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Isaiah Campbell, and LHP Bailey Horn. Those 15 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O'Neill, OF Masataka Yoshida, RHP Chris Martin, and OF Wilyer Abreu who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa (DFA), Criswell, Dalbec, Heineman, Campbell, Booser, and Valdez are back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.


