FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals and visiting San Diego Padres play the second game of a four-game series tonight at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals entered today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 10.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and 6.0 games back of Atlanta for the 3rd Wild Card spot.

O'BRIEN RECALLED: Prior to tonight's game, the Cardinals recalled RHP Riley O'Brien from Memphis (AAA) and designated RHP Shawn Armstrong for assignment ... After making his Cardinals debut on Opening Day at the Los Angeles Dodgers, O'Brien missed the next 117 games due to a right forearm flexor strain and then was activated/optioned to Memphis (AAA) on Aug. 12 ... In five Triple-A games since his option, O'Brien has yielded two hits over 5.1 scoreless innings while fanning four.

GOTTA BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST: The Cardinals are 5-5 over their current 22-game stretch against playoff contending teams: vs. LA Dodgers (1-2), vs. Brewers (2-1), at Twins (2-1), vs. Padres (0-1), at NY Yankees (3g), at Brewers (3g) and vs. Mariners (3g).

WHO'S YOUR PADRE: The Cardinals all-time .664 (170-86) home win pct. in St. Louis over the Padres (1969-present) is the 2nd-highest by one home team vs. any visitor in MLB history behind the Yankees (.668, 175-87) success over the Royals in New York (min 100 games). - Elias

• Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals .690 home win pct. (40-18) vs. the Friars is their 2nd-best against any visitor behind only Colorado (.734, 47-17).

• The Cardinals all-time .586 (300-212) win percentage over the Padres (1969-present) is their 5th-best against any opponent, while no NL team has higher all-time win pct. over San Diego than St. Louis.

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR CANDIDATES: San Diego's Jackson Merrill leads or shares the Major League rookie lead in hits (132), homers (19), batting average (.290), slugging (.488), OPS (.809), total bases (222), and extra-base hits (46), while Masyn Winn paces MLB rookies in defensive bWAR (2.1), position player bWAR (4.4), plate appearances (507), and at-bats (464), and ranks 2nd in batting average (.282), hits (131), multi-hit games (38), times on base (166), and total bases (195).

• Winn is aiming to become the first Cardinals rookie to lead his team in hits since 2001 NL Rookie of the Year Albert Pujols (194) and also lead all MLB rookies in hits since 1985 NL Rookie of the Year Vince Coleman (170) ... The last Cardinal to do both was Rogers Hornsby (155 hits in 1916). - Elias

BACKSTOP TRIOS: For the 4th time in Cardinals franchise history, three or more different Redbirds have each made 40+ starts at catcher this season (Wilson Contreras-50, Pedro Pagés-41, Iván Herrera-40), following 1927, 1957, and most recently 1998 (Eli Marrero-67; Tom Lampkin-54; Tom Pagnozzi-42) ... With 31 games remaining, the Cardinals could become only the 3rd team in MLB history to have three catchers each make 50+ starts in the same season (Elias):

• 2017 Tampa Bay Rays (80-82 record): Wilson Ramos (57), Derek Norris (52), & Jesus Sucre (51)

• 2012 San Diego Padres (76-86 record): Nick Hundley (56), rookie Yasmani Grandal (52), & John Baker (52).

REHABBING REDBIRDS: LHP Steven Matz (lower back strain) is scheduled to throw approx. 75 pitches with Memphis (AAA) at Iowa (AAA-Cubs) tonight, while Michael Siani (right oblique strain) begins an injury rehab assignment with Springfield (AA) at Wichita (AA-Twins) ... RHP Lance Lynn (right knee inflammation) is scheduled to make a rehab start on Sunday with Memphis in Iowa ... C Willson Contreras (fractured right middle finger) will avoid surgery with a possible in late September.

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Fernando Tatis, father of Padres outfielder, Fernando Tatis Jr., played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of Chan Ho Park.

Paul Goldschmidt's cousin, Dan Dallas, was selected by the Padres in the 7th round of the 2016 MLB Draft...played four minor league seasons in the Padres minor league organization (2016-19).

Miles Mikolas was selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB draft...pitched parts of two seasons with the Padres (2012-13), where he made his MLB debut...traded by San Diego with Jaff Decker to Pittsburgh for Alex Dickerson (Nov. 25, 2013).

Matt Carpenter played in 76 games for San Diego last season.

Tommy Pham played two seasons for San Diego (2020-21)...Traded by Tampa Bay with Jake Cronenworth to the Padres for Esteban Quiroz, Xavier Edwards, & Hunter Renfroe (Dec. 6, 2019).

Padres Hitting Coach **Victor Rodríguez** played two minor league seasons (1986-87) for the Louisville Redbirds (AAA) in the Cardinals organization.

David Peralta was originally signed by St. Louis as an International free agent pitcher (Sept. 26, 2004)...pitched three minor league seasons (2005-07) before transitioning to the outfield...underwent two left-shoulder surgeries...released in May 2009.

Mike Shildt coached and managed parts of 18 seasons in the Cardinals organization (2004-21)...served as area scout (2004-07) and coach (2005-08) before transitioning to minor league manager (2009-16)...Joined St. Louis coaching staff in 2017 and was Cardinals manager for parts of four seasons (2018-21)...led Cardinals to three postseason berths...2019 NL Manager of the Year.

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach **Mike McCoy** was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Donovan Solano played seven minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2005-11).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Padres Catching Coach **Brian Esposito** played parts of two seasons for Memphis (AAA) in 2006-07 and one game for St. Louis in 2007.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)...traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Athletic reporter **Katie Woo** spent the 2018 MLB season covering the Padres as an associate reporter for MLB.com.

Padres Coach **Peter Summerville's** brother, Andrew, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with Nate Tebbbs from the Padres for Heathcliff Slocumb and current Memphis (AAA) manager Ben Johnson.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor **Allen Craig** played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for Woody Williams (Aug. 2, 2001).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played part of the 2008 season for San Diego (26 games)...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for David Freese (Dec. 14, 2007).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

Cardinals broadcaster **Polo Ascencio** was born in nearby Tijuana, Mexico...considers Padres Eduardo Ortega as a broadcasting mentor.

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 27th start of the season and his 177th career (205th career appearance).
- Was originally selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB Draft and pitched parts of two seasons with the Padres (2012-13), where he made his MLB debut. Later traded to Pittsburgh with Jaff Decker for Alex Dickerson (Nov. 25, 2013).
- Leads MLB in first-pitch strike percentage (71.9%) this season, while his 67.1% career first-pitch strike percentage is tied with Phil Hughes (1291.0) for highest in MLB history among pitchers with 1,000 innings pitched.
- Sports the lowest Walk Pct. (4.7%) among active MLB pitchers (min. 500 innings).
- Has extensive home and road splits: 1-5 with a 5.94 ERA in 12 home starts and 7-5 with a 4.54 ERA in 14 road starts. The seven road wins rank T-2nd among N.L. pitchers.
- Seven (T-2nd in NL) of his eight wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, he has winning road record (34-29), but is just 24-27 at Busch Stadium. Ran off a streak of eight straight quality starts on the road before it was snapped in his 8/4 start at CHI, longest stretch of the season in MLB.
- Has thrown over 100 pitches in two of his 26 starts (101 at DET on 5/1 & 100 vs. LAD on 8/16) after ranking 7th in MLB with 12 such games in 2022. Ranks 2nd on the Cardinals with 2,223 pitches behind Kyle Gibson (2,221) and 21st in the National League.
- In his 166 starts w/ the Cardinals, St. Louis is 69-32 when Miles works 6.0+ IP (10-5 this season), while the Cardinals are 23-42 when he goes 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 48-6 (.889 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 64-15 in those 79 games). He's just 11-52 (.175) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 28-59). Has received two runs of support or fewer in seven of his last 10 starts (2-4, 6.04 ERA, 53.2 IP).
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 5th among Major League pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018. Erick Fedde (.992) ranks 4th.
- Amassed 1,000 career innings in the National League in his Aug. 9 start, becoming the 17th active pitcher in MLB to record 1,000 innings as a member of the National League.

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed two hits over 6.0 innings scoreless innings in the Cardinals 3-0 shutout win over the division-rival Brewers last Thursday at Busch Stadium. Issued just one walk to limit Milwaukee to three baserunners in the no-decision.
