WASHINGTON NATIONALS (62-78) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (66-74) SEPTEMBER 7, 2024 AT PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA - 1:35 & 6:40 EDT - GAME #141 & 142/HOME #70 & 71 DJ HERZ & MITCHELL PARKER vs. LUIS ORTIZ & MITCH KELLER

THE PIRATES: had their game postponed yesterday against the Nationals... Opened their season-long 10-game homestand with a 9-4 win Thursday night against the Nationals... Are 3-1 in their last four games...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven

innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven frames)...Have played in 47 one-run games, which are tied for the most among National League teams along with the Brewers...Have the best stolen base percentage (87.3 percent) in MLB...Are eighth in MLB with 59 quality starts (Seattle leads with 84)...Are hitting .339 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Royals (.378), Diamondbacks (.370) and Reds (.348)...Have the third-highest batting average (.256) in MLB in pinch-hit situations behind Baltimore (.350) and Arizona (.277)...Have scored the seventh-most runs (73) in MLB since August 22 behind the Cubs (114), Phillies (84), Brewers (82), Athletics (75) and Mariners (75).

COMING INTO HIS OWN: Luis Ortiz has recorded a 3.00 ERA (66.0ip/22er) since making his first start of the season on June 26...Ortiz' 3.00 ERA in that time is tied for 13th in all of MLB and tied for seventh among National League pitchers (teammate Paul Skenes' 2.13 ERA during that time ranks second in all of MLB).

GIMME FIVE: Andrew McCutchen has recorded an RBI in each of his last five games and a total of 15 RBI in his last nine contests dating back to August 7...It's the first time for McCutchen to record an RBI in five straight games since also doing so from May 21-25, 2019...Bryan Reynolds has the longest RBI streak by a Pirate this year (six straight games from June 19-25)...St. Louis' Luken Baker has the longest active RBI streak in MLB (six games).

LEADING OFF AND CLEANING UP: Andrew McCutchen is the oldest Pirates player in the modern era (since 1901) to start at least nine games in the leadoff spot and cleanup spot in the same season...The only other MLB player aged 37 years or older to do that over the past 20 years was Ben Zobrist in 2018.

PIRATING: Oneil Cruz has been successful in each of his last 19 attempts since being caught for the only time on April 22...The last Pirate to steal at least 19 consecutive bases without being caught in a single season is Nate McLouth (21 straight) from May 2 to September 28, 2008...Pittsburgh has 28 stolen bases in its last 24 games...The last time a Pirates runner was caught stealing was on August 7...Pittsburgh's 87.3 percent stolen-base success rate leads MLB....Since 1951, the only seasons in which Pittsburgh led MLB in that category are 1979 and 1997.

LET'S PLAY TWO: The Pirates will play their second doubleheader of the season today (also May 29 at Detroit) and their first at PNC Park since August 13 of last season against the Reds...It's also the first doubleheader at PNC Park for the Nationals since the team moved from Montreal in 2005...Prior to today, the last time the Pirates faced the Expos in Pittsburgh for a doubleheader was June 18, 2003 (before that it was twice in 1982).

DENNIS DEALING: Since August 11, Dennis Santana has issued just two hits in 41 at-bats (.049 batting average against)...Since June 18, Santana has recorded a 1.39 ERA (32.1ip/5er)...That's the sixth-lowest ERA among relievers in MLB with at least 32.0 innings of work behind Raisel Iglesias (0.00), A.J. Puk (0.28), Emparated Class (0.56). Tapper Scott (1.07) and Pine Walter (3.20). Emmanuel Clase (0.56), Tanner Scott (1.07) and Ryan Walker (1.30).

SUCCESSION OF SOUTHPAWS: Today begins a stretch of three straight games

the Pirates will be opposed by a starting left-handed pitcher (the Bucs are 21-21 in their previous 42 games)...Since July 1, Oneil Cruz has the fifth-highest batting average (.368) against left-handed pitchers in MLB among players with at least 50 at-bats...Joey Bart, who is hitting .392 this year against lefties, has 20 hits in his last 41 at-bats (.488) against southpaws.

51 BUCS: On Thursday Joey Wentz became the 51st player to appear in a game this season for the Pirates...The Pirates used 58 players in 2023.

FIRING CUBAN MISSILES: Aroldis Chapman comes into today tied for seventh in all of MLB among relief pitchers with 85 strikeouts...Chapman's 85 punchouts are the fifth-most in a single-season by a Pirates left-handed reliever...The only four Pirates southpaw relievers with more strikeouts in a single season are Rod Scurry (94 in 1982), Felipe Vazquez (90 in 2019), Felipe Vazquez (89 in 2018) and Félipe Rivero (88 in 2017).

BORN: January 27, 1999

AGE: 25 SIGNED: Thru 2024

HOW ACQUIRED: Signed by Pittsburgh as a non-drafted free agent on Oct. 2, 2018

STARTING OFF: The 25-year-old righthander is in his third Major League season, which have all come as a member of the Pirates...He has made 55 career appearances (30 starts) for the Bucs, including 22 relief appearances in 2024 (11 starts)...He made the first Opening Day roster of his career with the Pirates in 2024 after making just two appearances (both starts) with the club in 2022 and 18 appearances (15 starts) over two stints with the Bucs in 2023...Ortiz was signed by the Pirates as an international free agent on October 2, 2018.

STARTING OFF: Ortiz has posted a 3-2 record with a 2.95 ERA (64.0ip/21er), 48 strikeouts .189 batting average against as a starter this season.

- Dating back to his final start of the 2023 season until July 20, 2024, Ortiz threw 5.0-plus innings and allowed four or fewer hits in five consecutive starts, matching the second-longest such streak in club history...The only longer streak was six, accomplished by Francisco Liriano from July 17-Aug. 14, 2014.
- He threw at least 5.0 innings, allowed five or fewer baserunners and one or zero runs in each of his first four starts this season...That tied Cliff Lee (2008), Trevor Bauer (2020), Corbin Burnes (2021) and Carlos Rodon (2022) for the longest streak of such starts to begin a season in the modern era (since 1901).

ZERO TOLERANCE: Ortiz brings in a career-best scoreless streak of 15.0 innings into today...That's tied for the second-longest by a Pirate this season (Bailey Falter had a team-best scoreless streak of 19.2 innings from May 12-24)...Ortiz also had a scoreless streak of 12.0 innings earlier this year from July 2-13.

<u>VS. WASHINGTON:</u> Ortiz will make his second career appearance (first start) against Washington today...He allowed two runs in 1.0 inning of relief earlier this year on April 4 at Nationals Park.

FOR STARTERS: Today will be Ortiz' 31st career Major League start and his 12th of the season.

- Served in the bulk role following Carmen Mldozinski "opening" for the Bucs three times this season...Ortiz threw 4.1 shutout frames on June 8 vs. Minnesota, allowed one run in 5.0 innings on June 14 at Colorado and allowed six earned runs in 4.0 innings pitched on June 21 vs. Tampa Bay.
- He started 67 of his 72 appearances in the minor leagues from 2019-2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Ortiz allowed one hit in 6.0 innings and earned the win in a combined 3-0 shutout of the Guardians last Saturday at Progressive Field...Jalen Beeks, Dennis Santana and Aroldis Chapman worked the final 3.0 innings to preserve the win for the team's sixth shutout of the season.

WHAT THE METRICS SAY: Ortiz ranks in the 98th percentile in Fastball Run Value according to Baseball Savant...He has limited opposing hitters to a .178 batting average against (21-for-118) when using his four-seam fastball this season.

ON DECK: The 23-year-old Jones will make his 19th career start tomorrow...Allowed three runs in 6.1 innings but had a no-decision in the team's 5-3 comeback win Monday night against the Cubs...Has allowed a combined eight runs in 8.1 innings since being reinstated from the injured list on 8/27 (missed 46 games with a right lat strain)...Ranks sixth among all National League rookies in strikeouts (106) and fourth in batting average against (.226).

TODAY'S STARTER RHP MITCH KELLER #23

2024 RECORD: 11-9, 3.88 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-2/205 BATS/THROWS: R/R

BORN: April 4, 1996

AGE: 28 SIGNED: Thru 2028

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 2nd round of the 2014 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 28-year-old righthander is in his sixth Major League season... Keller signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 22, 2024...The 2023 All-Star has been Pittsburgh's Opening Day starter in each of the last two seasons, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16...He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller allowed four runs (3er) on 11 hits while losing a 6-1 decision Sunday at Cleveland...He surrendered three home runs in a game for the second time in his career (also July 23, 2023, against the Angels).

ON THE HOME FRONT: Keller has gone 5-3 with a 2.81 ERA (73.2ip/23er) in 12 starts this season at PNC Park (the Pirates are 8-4 in his 12 starts)...He ranks fifth all-time in PNC Park history in starts (63)...The only four pitchers to have more are Paul Maholm (100), Zach Duke (82), Charlie Morton (66) and Gerrit Cole (65).

LAST MONTH: Keller went 1-3 with a 6.75 ERA (24.0ip/18er) in five starts last month... He lost back-to-back starts on August 9 at Dodger Stadium and August 14 at San Diego...It marked the first he lost back-to-back starts since losing four straight starting assignments from July 18 to August 3 of last season.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Keller enters play among the NL leaders in several categories, including tied for 10th in run support (91), tied for 10th in wins (11) and 10th in innings pitched (157.2).

AS A STARTER: Keller has 127 starts as a member of the Pirates since making his big league debut in 2019...Keller's 127 starts are tied for 43rd in team history along with Gerrit Cole...Kip Wells ranks 42nd in team history with 128 starts.

VS. WASHINGTON: Keller will be making his fifth career start against the Nationals... He has posted a 5.57 ERA (21.0ip/13er) in his previous four starting assignments...He lost a 5-3 decision (5.1ip/5r/4er) in his start earlier this year on April 3 at Nationals Park...In his last start against the Nats here at PNC Park, he scattered two hits in 8.0 innings while winning a 2-0 decision on September 14 of last season.

AND THE WHIFF: In 2023, Keller set the club record by a right-handed pitcher with 210 strikeouts, surpassing the previous mark of 209 held by A.J. Burnett in 2013.
 Since the beginning of last season, Keller's 355 strikeouts are the fourth-most

 Since the beginning of last season, Keller's 355 strikeouts are the fourth-most among all right-handed pitchers in the National League...The only three National League right-handed pitchers to punch out more batters during that time are Zack Wheeler (402), Freddy Peralta (385) and Aaron Nola (364).

SEEING DOUBLE: Keller earned his 10th win of the season on July 8 against the Mets... Last year while being named to the National League All-Star team for the first time in his career, Keller recorded a career-high 13 wins.

 He is the first Pirate to record double-digit win totals in back-to-back seasons since Gerrit Cole, who did so in three straight years from 2013-15.

LET'S GO TO WORK: On May 6 against the Angels, Keller threw his second career complete game (his other complete game came on May 8, 2023 vs. Colorado)...Keller has worked at least 6.0 innings on 15 occasions this season...The Bucs are 13-2 on those 15 occasions, losing for the only times on April 20 against the Red Sox and on June 13 at St. Louis.
