FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals complete a four-game series and homestand this afternoon against the San Diego Padres. With a win, the Cardinals will split the four-game series but win the season series after the teams split the first six games 3-3. Following this afternoon's game, the Cardinals will fly to the Big Apple to begin a six-game road trip playing three games vs. the New York Yankees (Aug. 30-Sept. 1) then on to Milwaukee (Sept. 2-4) for three more games. Entering today, the Cardinals are in 3rd place in the National League Central, 10.5 games behind first place Milwaukee. The Cardinals are 7.0 games out of an N.L. Wild Card position, needing to pass Atlanta, New York, Chicago and San Francisco.

GOTTA BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST: The Cardinals are 6-6 over their current 22-game stretch against playoff contending teams: vs. LA Dodgers (1-2), vs. Brewers (2-1), at Twins (2-1), vs. Padres (1-2), at NY Yankees (3g), at Brewers (3g) and vs. Mariners (3g).

WHO'S YOUR PADRE: The Cardinals all-time .663 (171-87) home win pct. in St. Louis over the Padres (1969-present) is the 3rd-highest by one home team vs. any visitor in MLB history. - Elias

- Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals .683 home win pct. (41-19) vs. the Friars is their 2nd-best against any visitor behind only Colorado (.734, 47-17).

- The Cardinals all-time .586 (301-213) win percentage over the Padres (1969-present) is their 5th-best against any opponent, while no NL team has higher all-time win pct. over San Diego than St. Louis.

WALK-OFF WEDNESDAYS: Nolan Arenado's two-out, RBI single to score Masyn Winn in the 9th inning last night marked his 11th career walk-off RBI and 3rd as a member of the Cardinals. Two of those have come the last two Wednesday's at Busch Stadium as he hammered a walk-off grand slam vs. Milwaukee on August 21. Arenado ranks 5th among active players in walk-off RBI with teammate Paul Goldschmidt and trailing Freddie Freeman (14), Bryce Harper (14), Andrew McCutchen (12) and Carlos Santana (12).

GOLDY, JOLTIN' JOE, & DUCKY: With his next home run, Paul Goldschmidt will tie Joe DiMaggio (361 HR) for 86th all-time in MLB history (361 HR) and also match Joe Medwick (152 HR) for 14th in franchise history ... Tuesday night, Goldschmidt recorded his 11th season with 20 or more home runs, 2nd among active players behind Giancarlo Stanton (13 seasons).

SHUTDOWN SOUTHPAW: Cardinals left-handed reliever Matthew Liberatore issued a walk to Jake Cronenworth in the 6th inning last night snapping a stretch of 100 batters faced without walking a lefty. The last time he walked a left-handed batter was April 9 vs. Philadelphia giving a free pass to Kyle Schwarber. Liberatore has dominated in the month of August leading the Cardinals bullpen with 12 appearances, while his 0.55 ERA in the month ranks 3rd among relievers (Jason Foley - DET & Griffin Jax - MIN - 0.00 ERA). His three walks vs. LH batters are the fewest by a Cardinals pitcher facing 100 or more batters since Edward Mujica issued one walk vs. a LH in 2013. Only Will McEnaney (3 in 1979) and Dennis Eckersley (1 in 1996) join that Cardinals list.

A SIX-PACK ON A "SONNY" DAY: Today's starting pitcher Sonny Gray currently ranks 4th in the National League with 175 strikeouts. Gray is 30 strikeouts shy of his career-high of 205 with Cincinnati in 2019. His 12.87 strikeouts/9 IP (28.2 IP) in day games this season is the 2nd-highest total in Cardinals history of pitchers with 25.0 or more innings in day games and since Willard Schmidt (13.28) posted the franchise record in 1955 over 40.0 innings. Gray has struck out six or more batters in 11 straight starts, the longest active streak in MLB and tied for the longest in MLB this season (Tyler Glasnow, LAD, 11). It also marks the longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher since Chris Carpenter ran off 12 such starts in 2005.

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Fernando Tatis, father of Padres outfielder, Fernando Tatis Jr., played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of Chan Ho Park.

Paul Goldschmidt's cousin, Dan Dallas, was selected by the Padres in the 7th round of the 2016 MLB Draft...played four minor league seasons in the Padres minor league organization (2016-19).

Miles Mikolas was selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB draft...pitched parts of two seasons with the Padres (2012-13), where he made his MLB debut...traded by San Diego with Jaff Decker to Pittsburgh for Alex Dickerson (Nov. 25, 2013).

Matt Carpenter played in 76 games for San Diego last season.

Tommy Pham played two seasons for San Diego (2020-21)...Traded by Tampa Bay with Jake Cronenworth to the Padres for Estaban Quiroz, Xavier Edwards, & Hunter Renfroe (Dec. 6, 2019).

Padres Hitting Coach Victor Rodriguez played two minor league seasons (1986-87) for the Louisville Redbirds (AAA) in the Cardinals organization.

David Peralta was originally signed by St. Louis as an International free agent pitcher (Sept. 26, 2004)...pitched three minor league seasons (2005-07) before transitioning to the outfield...underwent two left-shoulder surgeries...released in May 2009.

Mike Schildt coached and managed parts of 18 seasons in the Cardinals organization (2004-21)...served as area scout (2004-07) and coach (2005-08) before transitioning to minor league manager (2009-16)...Joined St. Louis coaching staff in 2017 and was Cardinals manager for parts of four seasons (2018-21)...led Cardinals to three postseason berths...2019 NL Manager of the Year.

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach Mike McCoy was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Donovan Solano played seven minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2005-11).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Mark McGwire was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Padres Catching Coach Brian Esposito played parts of two seasons for Memphis (AAA) in 2006-07 and one game for St. Louis in 2007.

Hall of Famer Ozzie Smith was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)...traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Athletic reporter Katie Woo spent the 2018 MLB season covering the Padres as an associate reporter for MLB.com.

Padres Coach Peter Summerville's brother, Andrew, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres broadcaster Carlos Hernandez played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with Nate Tebbbs from the Padres for Heathcliff Slocumb and current Memphis (AAA) manager Ben Johnson.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor Allen Craig played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Ray Lankford played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for Woody Williams (Aug. 2, 2001).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Jim Edmonds played part of the 2008 season for San Diego (26 games)...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for David Freese (Dec. 14, 2007).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter Daniel Guerrero graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

Cardinals broadcaster Polo Ascencio was born in nearby Tijuana, Mexico...considers Padres Eduardo Ortega as a broadcasting mentor.

- Makes his 304th career appearance (295th start) and 25th start of the season as a member of the Cardinals.
- Is 11-0 (Cardinals are 13-2) when he receives two or more runs of support (while in the game) this season. Is 0-9 when he receives one or zero.
- Since 2014, Gray and teammate **Kyle Gibson** are the only two MLB pitchers with 10 or more seasons with 20 or more starts (2014-19, 2021-24).
- His 11 wins this season are his most since a career-high 14 in 2015 with Oakland, part of consecutive seasons (2014-15) with 14 wins.
- His 175 strikeouts in his first 24 starts with the Cardinals are the most in franchise history. He was the 9th Cardinal in history to record 100+ strikeouts in his first 14 starts of any season. **Bob Gibson** leads with four such seasons (1965, 1966, 1969, 1970).
- His 11.12 SO/9 IP is currently the highest single-season mark in franchise history. **Jack Flaherty** (10.59 in 2019) ranks 2nd-highest.
- Gray (1,712.2), **David Price** (2,143.0) and **Scott Sanderson** (2,561.2) are the only three Vanderbilt University baseball alums to surpass 1,700 innings in their MLB careers.
- Has allowed 20 HR this season, but only four at Busch Stadium: **Gunnar Henderson** (BAL, 5/20), **Patrick Bailey** (6/23, SF), **Brandon Lowe** (8/6, TB) & **Shohei Ohtani** (8/18).
- Despite missing first 11 games of season, his 121 strikeouts prior to All-Star break were the most by Cardinal since **Carlos Martinez** fanned 128 in 2017 (18 starts).
- Has a 57.3 strikeout pct. on his Sweeper pitch this season (fanning 92 in 171 plate appearances), MLB's 2nd-best K% of any pitch behind **Fernando Cruz** (62.5% Split-Finger) (minimum 100 plate appearances).
- Gray's 35.4 Put Away % on his sinker is the 2nd-highest of any MLB pitcher's pitch this season behind teammate **Ryan Helsley**'s slider (34.8%).
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
