FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a six-game road trip with the first of a three game series against the first place Milwaukee Brewers this afternoon. St. Louis entered today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 11.0 games back of Milwaukee and 5.0 games out of the 3rd Wild Card position.

RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals pounded out a 14-7 win over the New York Yankees to take the series at Yankee Stadium. A day earlier, they won their first regular season game against the Yankees in the Bronx and their first overall (including postseason) since October 12, 1964. The Cardinals are 7-2 against the Yankees under manager **Oliver Marmol** and 20-7 against American League teams with the skipper.

RECORD DAY: In the Cardinals 14-7 win over the New York Yankees yesterday afternoon, the Cardinals set season highs in runs (14), hits (21), doubles (6), extra base hits (9) and the longest 9-inning game of the season (3:21).

HEIR JORDAN: Yesterday at Yankee Stadium, 22-year old **Jordan Walker** recorded a career-high five hits and four runs scored. He was the first Cardinals player with five hits since **Matt Carpenter** in 2018 at Chicago. His five hits at 22-years, 102-days made him the youngest Cardinals player to have a five-hit day since **Rogers Hornsby** in 1916. He became the 16th player in MLB history to post a five-hit game under age 23 vs. the Yankees and most recent since **Rafael Devers** (BOS) in 2018 and outfielder since **Tony Conigliaro** (BOS) in 1967 (5-for-7) in a 7-6 loss.

LABOR DAYS: Since the franchise began in 1892, the Cardinals are 91-106-3 on Labor Day. On the road, the Cardinals are 37-95-1. The last time the Cardinals faced off against the Brewers on Labor Day was in 2011, dropping a 4-1 decision at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals are 2-1 on Labor Day against the Brewers all-time and 2-0 in Milwaukee.

SUNDAY SAVIOR: **Lars Nootbaar** hammered a go-ahead bases clearing double with two-outs in the 7th inning yesterday en route to a 14-7 win against the Yankees. Two innings later, Nootbaar hit a two-run home run (#9) for insurance in the 9th inning. His five RBI game marked a career-high and matched the season high by the Cardinals done by **Alec Burleson** earlier in the season vs. San Francisco. Nootbaar has had a penchant for coming through on Sunday as he hit a two-out, two-RBI go-ahead single the week prior at Minnesota in a 3-2 Cardinals win over the Twins.

HOMEGROWN: In yesterday's win, the Cardinals had seven home grown players in their starting lineup and one off the bench: **Masyn Winn** (2nd Rd.-2020), **Luken Baker** (2nd Rd.-2018), **Ivan Herrera** (Int'l FA-2016), **Brendan Donovan** (7th Rd.-2018), **Jordan Walker** (1st Rd.-2020), **Lars Nootbaar** (8th Rd.-2018), **Victor Scott II** (5th Rd.-2022), and pinch-hitter **Alec Burleson** (2nd Rd.-2020) came off the bench.

DR. RISP-ENSTEIN: Over the three-game series with the Yankees, the Cardinals exploded with clutch hitting batting .500 (15-30) with 7 extra base hits (4 doubles, 3 home runs) with runners in scoring position. In the 29 days preceding the Yankees series in August, the Cardinals batted .173 (36-208) with 10 extra base hits (8 doubles, 2 home runs) with runners in scoring position over 26 games.

LYNN MAKES INJURY REHAB START: **Lance Lynn** made his first injury rehabilitation assignment start yesterday for Memphis (AAA) at Iowa (Cubs). The veteran hurler threw 80 pitches (54 strikes) covering 3.2 innings. He struck out eight of his 20 total batters faced and allowed five runs on seven hits. Lynn has been out since July 31 with right knee inflammation.

PLEASE BE SEATED: Part of the Cardinals success over the weekend was limiting the Yankees power hitters to minimal damage in the three-game series. **Juan Soto** hit safely in all three games but was 4-for-14 (.286) with a double and an RBI in three games while **Aaron Judge** was 1-for-12 without an RBI or home run, two walks and seven strikeouts.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Ryan Helsley (April 16, 2019) made his MLB debut at Milwaukee.

Devin Williams was born in nearby Florissant, Mo...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Pre-season High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Cardinals AGM/Player Development **Gary LaRoque** was selected by Milwaukee in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB Draft.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** in exchange for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

Willson Contreras's younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

Bryan Hudson graduated from Alton (Ill.) High School, where he set school records for career wins (25) and strikeouts (324)...committed to the University of Missouri prior to being drafted by the Cubs in the 3rd round. of 2015.

Joe Ross's older brother **Tyson Ross**, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** and **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** is a Marquette Univ. graduate...started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Cardinals Dir. of Medical Ops/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay...graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

TODAY'S GAME

- Making his 16th start of the season today and his 26th career. It's his first career start against Milwaukee, with previous 12 appearances all coming in relief.
- The Cardinals have been victorious in each of his last three starts after having lost 5-straight from 7/10-8/10.
- Posted back-to-back starts of 7.0 innings or more against the Dodgers (8/17) and at the Twins (8/23).
- Began the season in the bullpen and was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine relief appearances, getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21.
- Was recalled on May 26 and has made 15 starts since, posting the lowest ERA (3.50) among Cardinals starters since then, the 11th best ERA in the National League. Padres Michael King is leading the list with a 2.21 ERA.
- Since May 26, leads all MLB starting pitchers with his 61.5 groundball pct.; has 152 ground balls and 47 flyballs allowed.
- Won his first three home starts (3-0, 2.87 ERA, 15.2 IP) this season, then lost three (0-3, 6.75 ERA, 16.0 IP) before he won again on 8/17 vs. LAD.
- Despite being winless in his four July starts, owned the Cardinals top starter's ERA (3.33) for the month and his .220 opponent's BA in July ranked 9th among N.L. starters.
- Has received three runs of support or less in 11-of-15 starts this season including 7 straight from June 28 to Aug. 10. Is 5-1 in his seven starts when receiving 3+ runs.
- Was involved in the decision in his first six starts and in 11 of 15 starts overall.
- His career reverse splits have continued this season, as he's held LHB to .222 BA & .579 OPS, while RHB are batting .269 with .737 OPS, hitting 4 of the 6 HR's he's allowed in 2024.
- Had his 17.0 IP scoreless innings streak as a starter snapped in an 8-5 defeat at HOU (6/4), pitched 3.0 innings allowing six runs.
- The scoreless inning streak had dated back to the 1st inning (3 runs allowed) of his 7/26/22 start at Toronto. Blanked Washington for 8.0 IP in 7/31/22 start at Nationals Park, followed by 6.0 scoreless IP in start at CIN (5/29/24).
- Is 9-8, 3.69 ERA in 25 career starts (136.2 IP/53 ER) and 7-4 with a 3.90 ERA in 108 career relief appearances (131.2 IP/57 ER).
- Was recalled on May 26 from Memphis (AAA), and made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington at Great American Ball Park vs. CIN (5/29).
- Appeared in four games (three starts) in Memphis (AAA) after being optioned from St. Louis on April 21, going 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP), 13 walks, nine strikeouts, and a 1.65 WHIP.
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 104 at KC on (8/10/24).

- Began the season in the bullpen and was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine relief appearances, getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21. Was recalled on May 26 and has made 13 starts since, posting the lowest ERA (3.75) among Cardinals starters and 15th lowest ERA in the National League.
- Made his first MLB start since 2022 at CIN (5/29), threw 6.0 scoreless innings at Great American Ball Park for a 5-3 win. Threw a then season-high 86 pitches (both Memphis & St. Louis) and did not allow a hit until the 4th inning.
- Made his second career appearance in a neutral site game when he started vs. SF (6/20) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala. Joined **Alan Benes** (4/19/1997 vs. SD) as the only two Cardinals starting pitchers to earn a win at a neutral site game.
- Logged a season-high 7.0 IP at PIT (7/4). His longest outing since a career-high 8.0 IP at WSH (7/31/22). Tossed a then career-high 101 pitches in his final start before the All-Star break in Game 1 of 7/10/24 split DH vs. KC.
- Suffered his first loss as a starting pitcher in 2024 and allowed runs as a starting pitcher for the first time since 2022 at HOU (6/4) in an 8-5 loss, allowing six runs on six hits
