The Brewers scored 10 runs in the ninth inning of last night's game....it marked the eighth time in franchise history that the team scored 10+ runs in an inning and first time in the ninth.

Willy for Three!

Willy Adames hit his 11th 3-run homer of the season last night, extending a franchise record....Adames leads the majors in 3-run home runs, the most since Albert Pujols also had 11 in 2006 with the Cardinals.

1-2 Punch

Willy Adames and William Contreras each homered in both games of the doubleheader yesterday....the duo joined Robin Yount and Rob Deer (6/23/89 vs. CWS) as the only teammates in franchise history to hit home runs in both games of a twinbill.

Action Jackson

In his last 70 games, Jackson Chourio has hit .314 (82-for-261) with 11 HR and 46 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .362 OBP/.521 SLG/.883 OPS.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 40-25 at home, going 13-6-2 in series play....are 7-1 in their last 8 home games....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks, coming from 5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 39-31 on the road, going 11-9-2 in series play....are 14-6 in their last 20 road games....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks, coming from 4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing Bud Black in June (42-54)....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009)....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 36 replay challenges this season, going 22-14....their last challenge (won) came on 8/23 at Oakland as an out call at first base involving Joey Ortiz was overturned.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #47 - RHP FRANKIE MONTAS (24gs, 6-9, 4.64)

MONTAS AT A GLANCE: Frankie Montas, 31, will be making his 25th start of the season and sixth with the Brewers.....Montas last started last Sunday at Oakland and took a 4-3 loss (6ip, 5h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 7k, 106 pitches).....his teams are 10-14 in his starts (4-1 with Brewers).....he has 7 quality starts.....opponents are batting .247 (115-for-465, 16hr)..... he was acquired by Milwaukee from Cincinnati on July 30 in exchange for RHP Jakob Junis, OF Joey Wiemer and cash.....he went 4-8 with a 5.01 ERA in 19 starts with the Reds (93.1ip, 93h, 56r, 52er, 41bb, 78k, 14hr).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 4/22-5/6 with a right forearm contusion.....he is 2-1 with a 3.33 ERA in 5 starts with the Brewers (27ip, 22h, 13r, 10er, 10bb, 28k, 2hr).....Montas is signed through the 2024 season with a mutual option for 2025.....name is pronounced "MOHN-tahs."

LAST SEASON: Montas was limited to just a single game last season with the Yankees, coming in relief on 9/30 at Kansas City.....he missed nearly the entire season while recovering from Feb. 21 right shoulder surgery.

CAREER: Is 43-44 with a 4.02 ERA in 154 games/123 starts (714ip, 319er).....is in his ninth Major League season with Chicago-AL (2015), Oakland (2017-22), New York-AL (2022-23), Cincinnati (2024) and Milwaukee (2024).....he pitched in the postseason with the Athletics in 2020 and 2022.....he had his best season in 2021 as he finished sixth in American League Cy Young Award voting after going 13-9 with a 3.37 ERA in 32 starts.....Montas was originally signed as a non-drafted free agent with Boston on 12/14/09.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 0-0 with a 4.73 ERA in 3 starts (13.1ip, 7er).....is 0-0 with a 2.70 ERA in 2 starts this season (10ip, 3er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 24-20 with a 4.60 ERA in 77 games/62 starts (344ip, 176er).....is 5-4 with a 5.05 ERA in 14 starts this season (71.1ip, 40er).

CAREER vs. REDS: Montas has never pitched against the Reds, one of just two teams he has not faced (also Miami).
