AT HOME: The Brewers are 38-25 at home, going 12-6-2 in series play... had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks, coming from 5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28.....had a 5-game home winning streak snapped last night.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 37-31 on the road, going 11-9-2 in series play.....the team is 12-6 in its last 18 road games.....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks, coming from 4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 36 replay challenges this season, going 22-14....their last challenge (won) came on 8/23 at Oakland as an out call at first base involving Joey Ortiz was overturned.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (26gs, 8-7, 3.86)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 28, will be making his 27th start of the season.....Peralta last started last Thursday at St. Louis and received no decision in the Brewers' 3-0 loss (5ip, 3h, 0r, 2bb, 2k, 1hbp, 92 pitches).....the team is 15-11 in his starts.....he has 10 quality starts.....opponents are batting .224 (118-for-526, 22hr).....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

CAREER: Is 50-34 with a 3.83 ERA and 1 save in 172 games/123 starts (723ip, 308er).....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-24).....has gone 42-32 with a 3.83 ERA as a starter (639ip, 272er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 29-18 with a 3.54 ERA in 91 games/63 starts (386ip, 152er).....is 4-4 with a 4.30 ERA in 13 starts this season (73.1ip, 35er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 21-16 with a 4.17 ERA in 81 games/60 starts (337ip, 156er).....is 4-3 with a 3.39 ERA in 13 starts this season (69ip, 26er).

CAREER vs. GIANTS: Is 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA in 3 games/2 starts against San Francisco, all coming at American Family Field (5.1ip, 8h, 10r, 4er, 5bb, 10k, 2hr).....took a 15-1 loss on 5/26 last season (2.1ip, 8h, 10r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 2hr).
