AT HOME: The Brewers are 40-25 at home, going 13-6-2 in series play.....are 7-1 in their last 8 home games.....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks, coming from 5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 40-32 on the road, going 12-9-2 in series play....are 15-7 in their last 22 road games.....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks, coming from 4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54)....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 36 replay challenges this season, going 22-14.....their last challenge (won) came on 8/23 at Oakland as an out call at first base involving Joey Ortiz was overturned.

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 28, will be making his 28th start of the season and fourth against the Cardinals.....he last started last Wednesday vs. San Francisco and earned a 5-3 win (6ip, 2h, 0r, 3bb, 8k, 105 pitches).....the team is 16-11 in his starts.....he has 11 quality starts.....opponents are batting .220 (120-for-545, 22hr).....he has tossed 13.0 consecutive scoreless innings.....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

CAREER: Is 51-34 with a 3.80 ERA and 1 save in 173 games/124 starts (729ip, 308er).....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-24).....has gone 43-32 with a 3.80 ERA as a starter (645ip, 272er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 30-18 with a 3.49 ERA in 92 games/64 starts (392ip, 152er).....is 5-4 with a 3.97 ERA in 14 starts this season (79.1ip, 35er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 21-16 with a 4.17 ERA in 81 games/60 starts (337ip, 156er)....is 4-3 with a 3.39 ERA in 13 starts this season (69ip, 26er).

RHP Aaron Civale will be making his 27th start of the season and 10th with the Brewers.....Civale last started last Thursday vs. San Francisco and earned a 6-0 win (7ip, 2h, 0r, 2bb, 7k, 92 pitches).....his teams are 10-16 in his starts (5-4 with Brewers).....he has 7 quality starts.....opponents are batting .256 (136-for-531, 24hr).....Civale was acquired from Tampa Bay on July 3 in exchange for INF Gregory Barrios....he has gone 3-2 with a 3.72 ERA in 9 starts with the Brewers (48.1ip, 43h, 22r, 20er, 19bb, 43k, 8hr).....he took a 7-2 loss in his only career start against St. Louis, coming with Cleveland on 8/30/20 at Busch Stadium (6ip, 8h, 5r, 5er, 2bb, 3k, 1bk).
