WASHINGTON NATIONALS (62-77) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (65-74) SEPTEMBER 5, 2024 AT PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #140/HOME #69 RHP JAKE IRVIN (9-11, 4.08 ERA) vs. LHP BAILEY FALTER (6-7, 4.41 ERA)

THE PIRATES: were no-hit and lost 12-0 in the finale of their three-game series last night at Wrigley Field...Went 3-3 on their road trip to Cleveland (1-2) and Chicago (2-1)... Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning).

nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven frames)...Have played in 47 one-run games, which are tied for the most in MLB along with the Mariners and Tigers (played 39 one-run games in all of 2023)...Have the best stolen base percentage (87.0 percent) in MLB...Are tied for fifth in MLB with 59 quality starts (Seattle leads with 83)...Are hitting .336 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Royals (.378), Diamondbacks (.377) and Reds (.364)...Have the third-highest batting average (.247) in MLB in pinch-hit situations behind Baltimore (.350) and Arizona (.279).

SETTING UP THE SERIES: The Pirates are 11-6 against the Nationals since the start of 2022...It's their best record against any National League opponent over that span...Pittsburgh and Washington have gone 48 straight series (minimum two games) without a sweep by either team, which is tied for the second-longest such streak by the Pirates against a single opponent all-time (58 vs. Dodgers from 1960-1971).

TAKING A STAND: Tonight the Pirates will begin their longest homestand of the season....The 10-game homestand will begin with this four-game series against the Nationals...The Bucs will then face the Marlins for three games beginning Monday night...Next Friday the Royals will visit PNC Park for three games...It will be Kansas City's first visit back to Pittsburgh since a two-game series from April 27-28, 2021.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Pirates were no-hit last night for the 12th time in club history...Prior to last night, the last time Pittsburgh was no-hit came on May 15, 2022, against Cincinnati here at PNC Park.

CAPITAL PUNISHMENT: Bryan Reynolds has a 1.076 career OPS against the Nationals...That's the highest among all active MLB players with at least 100 career plate appearances against them...It is his highest career OPS against any National League opponent.

GIMME FIVE: Andrew McCutchen has recorded an RBI in each of his last five games and a total of 15 RBI in his last nine contests dating back to August 7...It's the first time for McCutchen to record an RBI in five straight games since also doing so from May 21-25, 2019...Bryan Reynolds has the longest RBI streak by a Pirate this year (six straight games from June 19-25)...St. Louis' Luken Baker has the longest active RBI streak in MLB (six games).

DENNIS DEALING: Dennis Santana has retired each of his last 18 batters since allowing a single to Cincinnati's Santiago Espinal in the seventh inning on August 23...Beginning with his outing on August 11, Santana has issued just one hit in 37 at-bats (.027

batting average against) while also allowing just one walk in 13.1 innings.... Since June 18, Santana has recorded a 1.44 ERA (31.1ip/5er)...That's the fifth-lowest ERA among National League relievers with at least 31.0 innings of work behind Raisel Iglesias (0.00), A.J. Puk (0.28), Tanner Scott (1.10) and Ryan Walker (1.35).

CASHING IN AT PNC: Oneil Cruz has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games at PNC Park, going 18-for-44 (.409) with six doubles, six RBI and a .983 OPS...Cruz' .315 home batting average ranks 10th in all of MLB (Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. leads the way with a .388 average).

LET'S GO REYNOLDS: Bryan Reynolds recorded the 400th RBI of his career with

his three-run home run in the eighth inning in Monday's comeback win...Reynolds' 400 RBI ranks 39th in team history since RBI became an official stat in 1920...Reynolds also has 298 extra base hits in his career with the Pirates...His next extra base hit will tie him with Pirates Hall of Famer Manny Sanguillen for 36th in team history in that category.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Bailey Falter gets the start in the opener of this four-game series against the Nationals...Falter is holding the second lineup spot to a .145 average this season, which is the second-lowest in the National League (minimum 50 at-bats) behind Zach Wheeler (.120)...It is also the lowest such opponent average by a Pirate in a season over the past 50 years (minimum 50 at-bats).

BUCCO BLANKINGS: Pittsburgh has four shutout wins since August 20, which are the most in MLB over that span...The Pirates have shut out nine different teams this season, the second straight season they have done so (10 different teams last season).... Courtesy of StatsPerform.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

September 5, 2016: Andrew McCutchen went deep for the second time in three games and for the 20th time on the season in Pittsburgh's Labor Day contest against the Cardinals at PNC Park. McCutchen joined Ralph Kiner, Frank Thomas and Willie Stargell as one of just four Pirates in club history to hit at least 20 home runs in six consecutive seasons.

HOW ACQUIRED: From the Phillies in exchange for INF Rodolfo Castro on 8/1/23

STARTING OFF: The 27-year-old lefthander is in his second season with the Pirates after being acquired from the Phillies at the trade deadline last season (August 1) in exchange for infielder Rodolfo Castro...Falter is in his fourth Major League season...He made 50 appearances (24 starts) for the Phillies from 2021-23...He has also made 33 appearances (30 starts) with the Pirates from 2023-24 after being selected in the fifth round of the 2015 draft by Philadelphia.

AGAINST WASHINGTON: Falter will be making the eighth appearance and fifth start of his career tonight against the Nationals...Tonight is his first outing against Washington since starting and allowing one run in 6.0 innings while winning a 5-1 decision on September 12 of last season here at PNC Park...Falter is 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA (21.0ip/6er) in his four starts against the Nats.

LAST TIME OUT: Falter started the opening game of the team's road trip Friday night at Cleveland...He allowed four runs in 4.0 innings in the team's 10-8 loss.

AND THE WHIFF: Falter had a career-high tying eight strikeouts in his start on August 17 against the Mariners at PNC Park...It was his fourth career eight-strikeout game and second of the season after also punching out eight batters on April 23 against the Brewers at PNC Park.

ON REHAB: Falter missed a total of 17 games while being on the 15-day injured list from July 7-29 due to left triceps tendonitis...He made one rehab appearance with Triple-A Indianapolis on July 24 at Iowa, allowing two runs on five hits with three strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work.

IN THE BEGINNING: Falter has posted a 6.65 ERA (23.0ip/17er) during the first inning this season...After the first inning he has a 3.86 ERA (93.1ip/40er).

STAYING IN THE PARK: Falter has surrendered two home runs in 37.0 innings of work in his last nine starts dating back to his outing on June 24 at Cincinnati...His average of 1.08 home runs allowed per 9.0 innings is his best mark since breaking into the big leagues in 2021.

PUTTING UP ZEROES: Falter posted a scoreless streak of 19.2 innings earlier this season from May 12-24...It's the longest scoreless streak of this season by a Pirate.

GETTING HIS WORK IN: Falter has worked 116.1 innings this season, which is a career-high since breaking into the big leagues in 2021...Falter's single-season high for most innings in the minor leagues is 114.1 innings, which came in 2017 while playing for Lakewood in the South Atlantic League.

WHAT THE METRICS SAY: Per Baseball Savant, Falter has an average 7.4 foot extension when releasing the pitch, which ranks in the 98th percentile in Major League Baseball this season...He also ranked in the 99th percentile in 2023 and was in the 100th percentile from 2021-22.
