CHICAGO CUBS (65-66) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (62-68)

AUGUST 26, 2024 AT PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #131/HOME #66

RHP JAMESON TAILLON (8-8, 3.77 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (11-7, 3.76 ERA)

THE PIRATES: beat the Reds 4-3 in walkoff fashion yesterday in the finale of their four-game series...Are 6-4 in their last 10 games following their season-high 10-game losing streak from August 4-14...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have played in 47 one-run games, which are the most in MLB...Have won eight of 10 and 11 of their last 14 games when going deep multiple times in a game...Have the best stolen base percentage (85.4 percent) in MLB...Have recorded an extra base hit in a season-high 31 consecutive games (the third-longest active streak in all of MLB)...Have the third-most quality starts (57) in MLB behind the Mariners (79) and Royals (65)...Are hitting .347 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Royals (.371) Diamondbacks (.369) and Reds (.354).

ORDINARY AVERAGE GUY: Mitch Keller has a .195 batting average against the first time through the order in 2024, which is the third-lowest by a Pirates starting pitcher in the last 50 seasons (minimum 20 starts), behind only Francisco Liriano in 2014 (.193) and Doug Drabek in 1988 (.195).

GRANDAL CALLS GAME: Yasmani Grandal hit a two-run walkoff home run yesterday to give the Pirates a 4-3 win over the Reds...It was Pittsburgh's seventh walkoff win of the season and first by way of a home run since July 30 of last season against the Phillies...Prior to yesterday, Grandal's last walkoff home run came on August 28, 2020, against Kansas City while playing for the White Sox.

STAYING IN THE PARK: The Pirates have not allowed a home run in 115 batters faced...According to StatsPerform, that's the longest active streak in MLB...The Pirates' longest streak this season is 172, which was accomplished in both April and June.

SETTING UP THE SERIES: Tonight the Pirates begin a stretch that has the team playing the Cubs six times in the next nine games...In addition to this week, the Pirates will visit Wrigley Field for three night games from September 2-4 to close out a six-game road trip that gets underway in Cleveland this Friday...Five of the seven games this season between the Pirates and Cubs have been decided by one run, which is the highest percentage of games in a matchup decided by one run this season (minimum five games played).

CRUZ AND CATCH: Oneil Cruz has a .356 batting average in August, which is the highest in the month by a Pirate since Andrew McCutchen in 2013 (.384, minimum 20 games played in August)...Cruz' .356 average this month ranks fifth in all of MLB behind Aaron Judge (.425), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.367), Yordan Alvarez (.364) and Luis Garcia Jr. (.364).

CALL TO THE PEN: Pittsburgh's bullpen allowed two earned runs in 3.0 innings yesterday...The bullpen has recorded a 2.63 ERA since August 7, which is the fifth-lowest in MLB during that time...The only four teams to record a lower ERA since August 7 are the Rays (2.38), Nationals (2.54), Diamondbacks (2.55) and Astros (2.59).

CLOSE CALLS: The Pirates have played in a Major League-leading 47 one-run games (the Cubs rank second with 45)...Since July 31, 11 of Pittsburgh's 23 games have been decided by one run...Last season, Pittsburgh played in 39 one-run games, which ranked 27th in the league.

PIRATING: Oneil Cruz has been successful in each of his last 15 attempts since being caught for the only time on April 22...The last Pirate to steal at least 15 consecutive bases without being caught is Bryan Reynolds (16 straight) from August 5, 2022, to September 11, 2023...The last Pirate to steal at least 15 consecutive bases without being caught in a single season is Andrew McCutchen (15 straight) from April 11 to July 10, 2014...Pittsburgh has been successful in an MLB-best 85.4 percent of its stolen base attempts.

WELCOME BACK: Prior to tonight's game the Pirates recalled Henry Davis from Indianapolis and reinstated Nick Gonzales from the injured list...Davis reached base safely in his last 12 Triple-A games from August 9-24, going 17-for-49 (.347) with 10 RBI, seven walks, a .429 OBP and a .939 OPS...Gonzales went 5-for-15 (.333) with a solo home run in four games on rehab with the Indians...He is tied with Bryan Reynolds for the most game-winning RBI (eight) by a Pirate this season.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 2nd round of the 2014 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 28-year-old righthander is in his sixth Major League season... Keller signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 22, 2024...The 2023 All-Star has been Pittsburgh's Opening Day starter in each of the last two seasons, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16...He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller allowed three hits, struck out nine batters, and tossed 7.0-plus innings while earning the win in the team's 4-0 shutout on Tuesday at Texas.

CASHING IN AT PNC: Keller will be making his 12th start of the season here at PNC Park, where he has gone 5-2 while posting a 2.58 ERA (69.2ip/20er)...Since the beginning last year, he is 12-5 with a 2.76 ERA (159.2ip/49er) in 25 starts along the banks of the Allegheny River.

AGAINST THE DIVISION: Keller has gone 3-2 with a 3.59 ERA (47.2ip/19er) in eight starts this year against the National League Central...Both losses came against the Cardinals...

LEAGUE LEADERS: Keller enters play among the NL leaders in several categories, including fifth in run support (89), tied for fifth in wins (11), seventh in innings pitched (148.1) and 11th in home runs allowed per 9.0 IP (1.03).

#WINNING: The Pirates are 14-4 in Keller's last 18 starts since May 6 against the Angels...The team's four losses during the 18-game stretch came against the Cardinals on June 13 at Busch Stadium, vs. St. Louis and July 2 at PNC Park, at Dodger Stadium on August 9 and at San Diego on August 14.

VS. CHICAGO (NL): Keller has gone 5-4 with a 4.78 ERA (58.1ip/31er) in 12 career starts against the Cubs...Tonight will be his second start of the season after he earned the win on May 19 at Wrigley Field after allowing two runs in 6.0 innings...Keller has won each of his last three starts against the Cubs since losing a 3-2 decision on September 22, 2022, here at PNC Park.

AND THE WHIFF: In 2023, Keller set the club record by a right-handed pitcher with 210 strikeouts, surpassing the previous mark of 209 held by A.J. Burnett in 2013.

- Since the beginning of last season, Keller's 344 strikeouts are the fourth-most among all right-handed pitchers in the National League...The only three National League right-handed pitchers to punch out more batters during that time are Zack Wheeler (382), Freddy Peralta (374) and Aaron Nola (349).

SEEING DOUBLE: Keller earned his 10th win of the season on July 8 against the Mets... Last year while being named to the National League All-Star team for the first time in his career, Keller recorded a career-high 13 wins.

- He is the first Pirate to record double-digit win totals in back-to-back seasons since Gerrit Cole, who did so in three straight years from 2013-15.

LET'S GO TO WORK: On May 6 against the Angels, Keller threw his second career complete game (his other complete game came on May 8, 2023 vs. Colorado)...Keller has worked at least 6.0 innings on 15 occasions this season...The Bucs are 13-2 on those 15 occasions, losing for the only times on April 20 against the Red Sox and on June 13 at St. Louis.
