PITTSBURGH PIRATES (63-72) vs. CLEVELAND GUARDIANS (77-59)

SEPTEMBER 1, 2024 AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD, CLEVELAND, OH - 1:40 EDT - GAME #136/ROAD #68

RHP MITCH KELLER (11-8, 3.84 ERA) vs. RHP ALEX COBB (1-1, 4.35 ERA)

THE PIRATES: shut out the Guardians 3-0 last night...Have 10 shutouts this season, which are the sixth-most in the National League (Philadelphia leads the way with 14)... Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have played in 47 one-run games, which are the most in MLB (played 39 one-run games in all of 2023)...Have the best stolen base percentage (86.7 percent) in MLB...Have recorded an extra base hit in a season-high 36 consecutive games (the fourth-longest active streak in all of MLB)...Are tied for sixth in MLB with 58 quality starts (Seattle leads with 81)...Are hitting .340 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Royals (.384) Diamondbacks (.375) and Reds (.353)...Have the fourth-highest batting average (.239) in MLB in pinch-hit situations...Have gone 8-11 in the rubber game of a series...Are 8-11-2 in their first 21 road series...Have gone 8-4 against teams from the American League Central (Pittsburgh's last series against an AL Central team will be against the Royals from September 13-15).

ON BASE WITH ONEIL: Oneil Cruz has reached base safely in each of his last 22 games, which is the third-longest active streak in MLB behind Francisco Lindor (29 games) and Yordan Alvarez (24 games)...Cruz is hitting .373 (31-for-83) with eight doubles, one triple, one home run, 12 RBI and a .966 OPS since the streak began on August 7.

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Oneil Cruz hit .389 last month, which paced all of MLB...Cruz' .389 average was the highest by a Pirate (minimum 80 at-bats) during the month of August since Matty Alou hit .403 in 1967...Cruz also finished last month fifth in MLB with a .449 on-base percentage...The only players with a higher OBP were Aaron Judge (.530), Yordan Alvarez (.481), Joc Pederson (.467) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.454).

STREAKING CUTCH: Andrew McCutchen brings a season-high 13-game hitting streak into today, which is tied for the longest active streak in MLB along with Carlos Correa...McCutchen has gone 17-for-51 (.333) with two doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI and a 1.034 OPS during his current 13-game hitting streak... McCutchen's last single-season hitting streak of more than 13 games came in 2015 when he hit safely in a career-high 18 straight games with the Pirates... McCutchen has also reached base safely in 14 straight games, which is tied for the fourth-longest active streak in MLB.

GETTING ROWDY: Rowdy Tellez delivered a pinch-hit, two-run single last night and is now hitting .423 (11-for-26) with a double, two home runs and eight RBI in his last eight games...Tellez has recorded multiple RBI in three straight games for the first time in his career...In addition, he is hitting .426 (20-for-47) while batting with runners in scoring position since the beginning of June.

COMING INTO HIS OWN: Luis Ortiz has recorded a 3.00 ERA (66.0ip/22er) since making his first start of the season on June 26...Ortiz' 3.00 ERA in that time ranks 14th in all of MLB and ninth among National League pitchers (teammate Paul Skenes' 2.30 ERA during that time ranks third in all of MLB).

PIRATING: Oneil Cruz has been successful in each of his last 17 attempts since being caught for the only time on April 22...The last Pirate to steal at least 17 consecutive bases without being caught in a single season is Nate McLouth (21 straight) from May 2 to September 28, 2008... Pittsburgh has stolen a base in each of its last six games and has 17 steals in its last 11 games... The last time a Pirates runner was caught stealing was on August 7...Pittsburgh's 86.7 percent stolen-base success rate leads MLB... Since 1951, the only seasons in which Pittsburgh led MLB in that category are 1979 and 1997.

ON THE OFFENSE: The Pirates have scored 53 runs since being shut out 1-0 on August 21 against the Rangers...Pittsburgh's 53 runs scored since August 22 are the third-most in all of MLB...The only two teams to score more runs during that time are the Cubs (85) and Brewers (62)...The Pirates hit .257 last month, which ranked ninth in MLB.

THE BEAR FACTS: The Pirates will continue their six-game road trip tomorrow night when the team begins a three-game series at Wrigley Field...The Pirates took three of four games at the Friendly Confines from May 16-19.

Luke Walker picked up the win, as he pitched the final 6.0 innings of the ballgame and allowed just one run on two hits.

TODAY'S STARTER RHP MITCH KELLER #23

2024 RECORD: 11-8, 3.84 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-2/205 BATS/THROWS: R/R

 HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 2nd round of the 2014 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 28-year-old righthander is in his sixth Major League season... Keller signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 22, 2024...The 2023 All-Star has been Pittsburgh's Opening Day starter in each of the last two seasons, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16...He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller allowed three runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings while losing an 18-8 decision against the Cubs Monday night at PNC Park.

ON THE ROAD: Today is Keller's 15 starting assignment on the road this season, where he has a 6-5 record and 4.81 ERA (78.2ip/42er)...Keller's last start on the road came against the Rangers on August 20...He tossed 7.0-plus innings, scattered three hits, and won a 4-0 decision.

LAST MONTH: Keller went 1-3 with a 6.75 ERA (24.0ip/18er) in five starts last month... He lost back-to-back starts on August 9 at Dodger Stadium and August 14 at San Diego...It marked the first he lost back-to-back starts since losing four straight starting assignments from July 18 to August 3 of last season.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Keller enters play among the NL leaders in several categories, including sixth in run support (91), tied for seventh in wins (11), tied for eighth in innings pitched (152.1) and 12th in home runs allowed per 9.0 IP (1.00).

AS A STARTER: Keller has made 126 starts as a member of the Pirates since making his big league debut in 2019...Keller's 126 starts are tied for 44th in team history along with Kris Benson and Don Robinson...Today's start will tie him with Gerrit Cole for 43rd in team history in career starts.

VS. CLEVELAND: Keller will be making his third career start today against the Guardians...Last year he allowed eight runs in 6.0 innings while losing a 10-1 decision against Logan Allen on July 18 at PNC Park...He also tossed 5.0 no-hit innings and allowed one run in a no-decision in the team's 4-3 loss here in Cleveland on September 25, 2020 (the Indians walked off the Bucs with a three-run ninth inning).

AND THE WHIFF: In 2023, Keller set the club record by a right-handed pitcher with 210 strikeouts, surpassing the previous mark of 209 held by A.J. Burnett in 2013.

- Since the beginning of last season, Keller's 348 strikeouts are the fourth-most among all right-handed pitchers in the National League...The only three National League right-handed pitchers to punch out more batters during that time are Zack Wheeler (395), Freddy Peralta (382) and Aaron Nola (355).

SEEING DOUBLE: Keller earned his 10th win of the season on July 8 against the Mets... Last year while being named to the National League All-Star team for the first time in his career, Keller recorded a career-high 13 wins.

- He is the first Pirate to record double-digit win totals in back-to-back seasons since Gerrit Cole, who did so in three straight years from 2013-15.

LET'S GO TO WORK: On May 6 against the Angels, Keller threw his second career complete game (his other complete game came on May 8, 2023 vs. Colorado)...Keller has worked at least 6.0 innings on 15 occasions this season...The Bucs are 13-2 on those 15 occasions, losing for the only times on April 20 against the Red Sox and on June 13 at St. Louis.
