PITTSBURGH PIRATES (65-73) vs. CHICAGO CUBS (71-68)

SEPTEMBER 4, 2024 AT WRIGLEY FIELD, CHICAGO, IL - 6:40 CDT - GAME #139/ROAD #71 RHP DOMINGO GERMÁN (0-0, 6.11 ERA) vs. LHP SHOTA IMANAGA (11-3, 3.14 ERA)

THE PIRATES: shut out the Cubs 5-0 last night to earn a series win... Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)... Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven frames)...Have played in 47 one-run games, which are tied

for the most in MLB along with the Mariners (played 39 one-run games in all of 2023)...Have the best stolen base percentage (87.0 percent) in MLB...Are tied for fifth in MLB with 59 quality starts (Seattle leads with 82)...Are hitting .336 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Diamondbacks (.381), Royals (.378) and Reds (.349)...Have the third-highest batting average (.247) in MLB in pinch-hit situations behind Baltimore (.356) and Arizona (.282)...Have scored the fifth-most runs (59) in MLB since August 22 behind the Cubs (102), Diamondbacks (79), Brewers (78) and Dodgers (70).

THE ARMS RACE: Last night the Pirates tossed their 11th shutout of the season and second in four games...Pittsburgh's 11 shutouts are the most since 2018 when the team had sixteen... Pittsburgh's starting rotation comes into today ranked sixth in all of MLB with a 3.82 ERA (the Cubs rank seventh with a 3.82 ERA)...The only five starting rotations in MLB to record a lower ERA are the Mariners (3.38), Phillies (3.58), Royals (3.64), Tigers (3.71) and Braves (3.77).

CHECKING THE BROOM CLOSET: Tonight the Pirates will look for their third sweep of the season and first since July 12-14 against the White Sox...The Pirates began the 2024 campaign with a four-game sweep of the Marlins on the road from March 28-31...The last time the Pirates swept the Cubs in three games at Wrigley Field was April 14-16, 2017.

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Pirates are 5-1 at Wrigley Field this season heading into the finale of their three-game series tonight...Pittsburgh's pitching staff has recorded a 2.03 ERA (53.1ip/12er) in first six games here this year, including a 1.95 ERA (37.0ip/8er) by the starting rotation...The Pirates have now won three straight series at Wrigley Field for the first time since a four-series winning streak spanning 2013 and 2014.

TAKING A STAND: Tomorrow night the Pirates will begin their longest homestand of the season....The 10-game homestand will begin with a four-game series against the Nationals...The Bucs will then face the Marlins for three games beginning Monday night...The Royals will close out the homestand with a three-game series that gets underway next Friday...It's the first time

the Pirates will face both the Marlins and Nationals since their season-opening road trip from March 28 to April 4...It will be Kansas City's first visit back to Pittsburgh since a two-game series from April 27-28, 2021.

GIMME FIVE: Andrew McCutchen has recorded an RBI in each of his last five games and a total of 15 RBI in his last nine contests dating back to August 7... It's the first time for McCutchen to record an RBI in five straight games since also doing so from May 21-25, 2019...Bryan Reynolds has the longest RBI streak by a Pirate this year (six straight games from June 19-25)...Milwaukee's Willy Adames has the longest active RBI streak in MLB (six games).

SOUTHPAW SIGHTING: Tonight will be the 42nd time this season the Pirates are opposed by a starting left-handed pitcher (the Bucs are 20-21 in the previous 41 games)...Oneil Cruz is hitting .389 (21-for-54) against lefties since the beginning of July...That's the fourth-highest average in all of MLB among

players with at least 50 at-bats behind Ketel Marte (.420), Yordan Alvarez (.412) and Jackson Chourio (.403).

THE BEAR FACTS: Jared Triolo is 13-for-38 (.342) in 11 games this year against the Cubs...Triolo's nine RBI this year against the Cubs are tied for the second-most by any player along with teammate Connor Joe and Milwaukee's Willy Adames...Cincinnati's TJ Friedl leads all players with 13 RBI against the Cubs...Connor Joe has four homers this year vs. Chicago, which are the most by any player...The Pirates have scored 66 runs and hit 20 bombs in their first 12 games this year against the Cubs...The next two closest teams are St. Louis and Milwaukee with 51 runs apiece in 13 games.

DENNIS DEALING: Dennis Santana has retired each of his last 18 batters since allowing a single to Cincinnati's Santiago Espinal in the seventh inning on August 23...Beginning with his outing on August 11, Santana has issued just one hit in 37 at-bats (.027 batting average against) while also allowing just one walk in 13.1 innings....Since June 18, Santana has recorded a 1.44 ERA (31.1ip/5er)...That's the fourth-lowest ERA among National League relievers with at least 31.0 innings of work behind A.J. Puk (0.28), Tanner Scott (1.14) and Ryan Walker (1.35).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

September 4, 1992: Andy Van Slyke doubled three times while Randy Tomlin started and allowed one unearned run in 8.0 in Pittsburgh's 6-5 win against the Dodgers. The Dodgers scored four times in the ninth inning before the Buc would answer with three runs of their own in the half of the ninth while winning it on a Don Slaught pinch-hit, run-scoring walkoff single.

HOW ACQUIRED: Signed as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024

STARTING OFF: The 32-year-old righthander is in his first season with the Pirates after being signed as a minor league free agent during spring training on March 16...He began his professional career in the Marlins organization after signing as a non-drafted free agent in 2010 before being acquired by the Yankees on December 19, 2013, along with pitcher Nathan Eovaldi and infielder Garrett Jones, in exchange for pitcher David Phelps and infielder Martin Prado.

LAST TIME OUT: Germán allowed two runs on five hits in 3.0 innings of relief in his last appearance Friday night against the Guardians at Progressive Field.

VS. CHICAGO (NL): Will be making his third career appearance (second start) tonight against the Cubs...He allowed eight earned runs in 2.2 innings of relief in his only appearance against the Cubs this year on August 26 at PNC Park...He also allowed two runs (1er) in 6.0 innings but had a no-decision in his only start against the Cubs on July 9 of last season as a member of the Yankees.

FOR STARTERS: Germán made his only start of the season with the Pirates on August 21 at Texas...He scattered three hits in 6.0 innings but came away with a no-decision... The Rangers walked off the Bucs in the ninth inning when Wyatt Langford singled home Ezequiel Duran for the only run of the game.

PIRATES DEBUT: The Pirates selected Germán's contract on August 9...He made his Pirates debut that night at Dodger Stadium, where he allowed two runs on one hit in 4.0 innings of relief in the team's 9-5 loss.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Germán was assigned to the Florida Complex League to begin the 2024 season before making his season debut with Low-A Bradenton on May 14, where he started and gave up one run and struck out four batters in 4.0 innings at Tampa...He made one appearance with the Marauders before being promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on May 19.

STREAKING AT INDY: Germán won each of his last six decisions with Indianapolis, going 6-0 with a 4.36 ERA (43.1ip/21er) and 43 strikeouts in eight starts from June 18 thru August 3.

THE MARK OF ZERO: Germán is wearing uniform #0, the same number he wore in his final season with the Yankees in 2023...The last Pittsburgh player to wear #0 was catcher Junior Ortiz in 1989...LHP Joe Page wore 00 with the Pirates in 1954 and RHP Rick White also sported 00 with the Bucs in 2005.

PERFECT DAY: Germán threw the 24th perfect game in Major League history and the fourth in Yankees history on June 28, 2023 at Oakland...He joined David Cone (July 18, 1999 vs. Montreal), David Wells (May 17, 1998 vs. Minnesota) and Don Larsen (1956 World Series Game Five on October 8, 1956 vs. Brooklyn) as the only pitchers in Yankees history to throw a perfect game...He was the first Dominican-born pitcher to throw a perfect game...
