FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a six-game road trip with the second of a three-game series against the first place Milwaukee Brewers this afternoon. St. Louis entered today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 12.0 games back of Milwaukee and 5.5 games out of the 3rd Wild Card position. The Cardinals are 2-2 on this current road trip after taking 2-of-3 at the New York Yankees.

RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals fell to the Brewers 9-3 on a Labor Day afternoon matinee at American Family Field yesterday. **Pedro Pagés** recorded his first career multi-home run game with two solo home runs (#5). Milwaukee got all nine of their runs on three home runs, a two-run shot by **Rhys Hoskins**, a three-run by **Willy Adames** and a grand slam by rookie **Jackson Chourio**.

GIVE ME THE NIGHT: The Cardinals will be playing their first night game since Friday night in the Bronx. The three straight day games was their most consecutively this season spanning over two road cities. They played three straight day games in Chicago (June 14-16) and Washington D.C. (July 6-8). The last time the Cardinals played three straight day games over two cities was June 17-19, 2023 with two afternoon tilts in New York before a Juneteenth 4:05 start in Washington D.C.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Paul Goldschmidt extended his hitting streak to nine games for the third time this season with a double to right field in the 6th inning yesterday. Goldschmidt has a double in a career-high five straight games, the most by a Cardinals player since **Matt Carpenter** rapped out a two-bagger in six straight from June 10-15, 2017. **Yadier Molina** holds the club record with a double in eight straight games. Goldschmidt's last hitting streak of 10 games or more was 25 games from May 7-June 3, 2022.

RETURN OF THE MATZ: Tonight marks the return of Cardinals LHP **Steven Matz**, who had been on the Injured List since May 1 with a lower back strain. Matz made six injury rehabilitation assignment starts in Memphis (AAA) and was 0-1 with a 4.29 ERA over 21.0 innings with 17 strikeouts. Matz last faced the Brewers in a relief role on Sept. 28, 2022, the day after the Cardinals clinched the National League Central. He has yet to allow a run against Milwaukee as a member of the Cardinals bringing a 6.2 inning scoreless streak over two appearances.

BAKER STREET: Rookie **Luken Baker** hit a sacrifice fly in his lone pinch-hit plate appearance yesterday, but in the process ran his RBI streak to five games. According to *Elias Sports Bureau*, Baker joins **Jeremy Hazelbaker** (Apr. 6-11, 2016 - 5 games) and **Albert Pujols** (May 10-16, 2001 - 6 games & May 4-8, 2001 - 5 games) as the only Cardinals players in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to run off RBI streaks of five or more games in their first 43 Major League games.

VOTE FOR PEDRO!: Rookie catcher **Pedro Pagés** hit two home runs yesterday off **Freddy Peralta** becoming the first Cardinals rookie catcher to post a multi-home run game since **Gus Mancuso** smacked two solo shots off **Hal Elliott** of the Philadelphia Phillies on September 20, 1930 at the Baker Bowl.

MIL-WALK-EE: When outfielder **Lars Nootbaar** walked in his first plate appearance yesterday, it marked the fifth straight game against the Brewers he's been issued a free pass. Nootbaar's five straight games with a walk vs. Milwaukee is the 2nd-longest active streak behind **Aaron Judge**, who has been passed in 11 straight games (7/8/17-4/28/24) by the Brewers. Nootbaar's streak is the longest by a Cardinals player since **Matt Carpenter** with seven games (5/29/18-8/17/18), one behind the Cardinals all-time mark of eight by **Albert Pujols** (2005-06) and **Mark McGwire** (1999-2000).

GRAND EXIT: When Brewers' rookie **Jackson Chourio** hit his grand slam in the 6th inning yesterday off **Riley O'Brien**, it marked only the second grand slam allowed by Cardinals pitchers this season and first since Arizona's **Pavin Smith** cleared the bases off **Zack Thompson** on April 23 at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals two grand slams rank as tied for the 2nd-fewest in MLB to the Detroit Tigers with one. The two slambuskis are their fewest allowed in a season since 2020 (1) and the fewest in a non-shortened season since 2014, also one allowed.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Ryan Helsley (April 16, 2019) made his MLB debut at Milwaukee.

Devin Williams was born in nearby Florissant, Mo...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Pre-season High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Cardinals AGM/Player Development **Gary LaRoque** was selected by Milwaukee in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB Draft.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** in exchange for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

Willson Contreras's younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

Bryan Hudson graduated from Alton (Ill.) High School, where he set school records for career wins (25) and strikeouts (324)...committed to the University of Missouri prior to being drafted by the Cubs in the 3rd round. of 2015.

Joe Ross's older brother **Tyson Ross**, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** and **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** is a Marquette Univ. graduate...started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Cardinals Dir. of Medical Ops/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay...graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

- Making his 7th start of the season and first start in the Major Leagues since April 30 at Detroit in Game 2 of a doubleheader.
- Made six injury rehabilitation starts with Memphis (AAA) from Aug. 1-30, posting an 0-1 record with 4.29 ERA. Ramped up to 85 pitches vs. Charlotte on Aug. 21 and pitched a high of 5.0 innings.
- Surpassed 900 career innings with his fifth out at Oakland (April 17) becoming the 20th active left-handed pitcher with 900 or more innings pitched.
- Made his first start of the season against the Dodgers on Sunday Night Baseball in Los Angeles on March 31 and received a no-decision after departing with a 4-2 lead in the 6th.

- Took his first loss in a rehab start pitching 3.0 innings and allowing four runs on six hits in a 4-3 loss at Iowa (AAA-Cubs), departing trailing 4-0.

2024 SEASON

- Suffered a lower back strain after his start in the second game of a doubleheader in Detroit on April 30 and missed the next 105 games.
- Had injury rehabilitation assignments June 6-17 (Memphis-AAA & Springfield-AA) and August 1-30 (Memphis-AAA).
- Ran off a 5-game win streak from last season snapped in his start at OAK (4/17) allowing a season-high five runs in a 6-3 loss.
- Surpassed 900 career innings with his fifth out at OAK (4/17) becoming the 20th active left-handed pitcher with 900 or more innings pitched.

2023 SEASON

- Made 25 appearances (17 starts) between the starting rotation and bullpen in 2023
- Limited left-handed batters to a .215/.295/.304 slashline (17-79) with three extra-base hits (two home runs and double).
- Recorded a season-high 17.0 scoreless innings streak from July 20-August 5), longest by a Cardinal pitcher in 2023.
- Opened season making 10 starts in the rotation, starting 0-6 with a 5.72 ERA (50.1 IP) and 45 strikeouts. Received 16 runs of support while St. Louis was 2-8 in those games.
- Moved to the bullpen in late May, and made eight relief appearances, logging a 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP) with 15 strikeouts and .224 average against.
- Allowed runs in only three of eight relief appearances, while working 2.0+ IP in four outings.
- As a starter, went 4-6 with a 4.04 ERA (89.0 IP) in 17 starts.
- Pitched 5.0 innings or more in 13-of-17 starts (four quality).
- Hurled career-high 3.1 scoreless innings in relief (3.1) twice, garnering 10 scoreless outs, in London vs. Cubs (6/24) and vs. Astros (6/29).
- Returned to the starting rotation on July 9, finishing his season 4-0 with a 1.86 ERA (8 ER/38.2 IP) and 38 strikeouts in his final seven starts. Held his opposition to two runs or fewer in six of starts, including one run or fewer in five.
- Over that seven-start span from July 9-Aug. 12, ranked among MLB leaders in wins (T-2nd), innings (T-4th), ERA (3rd), average against (.190, T-7th), opponent OPS (.537), WHIP (0.88, 5th), BR/9 (7.91, 3rd), and FIP (2.85, 4th).
- Missed the final 44 games of season due to a left lat strain.

- Last faced the Brewers in 2022, throwing 6.2 scoreless innings in two appearances (one start), both at American Family Field.
- Has pitched 5.1 innings or more in all seven career starts vs. Milwaukee.
- His five wins vs. the Brewers (5-2) are his most against any N.L. Central opponent.
- Has never faced Milwaukee at Busch Stadium III as a member of the Cardinals.
- Made 2 starts as a member of the Mets in 2019 over a five-day span, earning a win at Citi Field (April 28, 2019) and taking a loss a week later in Milwaukee (May 3, 2019).
- Won three straight starts (April 13, 2018-April 28, 2019) vs. the Brewers.

CAREER

- Joined the Cardinals on a four-year contract (2022-25) after previously pitching for the New York Mets (2015-20) and Toronto Blue Jays (2021) organizations.
- Missed 102 games on the Injured List in 2022 with a left shoulder impingement (5/23-7/16) and strained left knee (7/24-9/16). Was activated from his second stint in mid-September and was added to the bullpen where he made five appearances.
- Prior to the 7/23/22 start at Cincinnati, Matz had missed approx. two months with a left shoulder impingement.
- Has landed on the Injured List 11 times over his Major League career, missing time in every season except for 2021 in which he missed time for a positive COVID-19 test.
- In 2021, tied for the American League lead with 14 wins among left-handed pitchers.
