**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue a six-game road trip with the final of a three game series against the first place New York Yankees this afternoon. The Cardinals and Yankees represent the World Series Championship leaders in each league with the Cardinals boasting 11 in the National League and the Yankees with 27 in the American League. The Cardinals defeated the Yankees in the 1926, 1942 and 1964 World Series and lost to them in 1928 and 1943. St. Louis entered today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 12.0 games back of Milwaukee and 6.0 games out of the 3rd Wild Card position.

**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals evened the series with the Yankees holding off the Bronx Bombers 6-5 yesterday afternoon as **Ryan Helsley** locked down his MLB-leading 42nd save to preserve the win for **Kyle Gibson (8-6)**. **Brendan Donovan** hit his 11th home run of the season, a 3-run shot during a four-run 3rd inning.

**WHAT'S IN A NAME?:** With the Cardinals win yesterday in the Bronx, it shattered a 60-year span in which the team hadn't won in this location, last earning a win in Game 5 of the World Series on October 12, 1964 at original Yankee Stadium, 5-2 in 10 innings. In that game, **Bob Gibson** threw 10 innings for the win, while yesterday, **Kyle Gibson** pitched seven innings for the win. Also, legendary broadcaster **Harry Caray** was on the call for KMOX in 1964, and 60 years later, Harry's grandson, **Chip Caray** (Harry III) was calling the game for the Cardinals television rightsholder Bally Sports Midwest.

**MATZ ACTIVATED:** The St. Louis Cardinals activated LHP **Steven Matz** (lower back strain) from the 60-day Injured List to the roster, expanded today on September 1. Matz' 30-day injury rehabilitation assignment ended yesterday as the southpaw made six starts for Memphis (AAA) and was 0-1 with a 4.29 ERA covering 21.0 innings with four walks opposing 17 strikeouts. Matz last pitched in a Major League game on April 30 at Detroit.

**WHEN RUBBER MEETS ROAD:** The Cardinals are playing in their 18th rubber match game of the 2024 season. St. Louis has won their last two series-clinching rubber match games and are 10-7 overall this season.

**GOTTA BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST:** The Cardinals are 8-7 over their current 22-game stretch against playoff contending teams: vs. Los Angeles-NL (1-2), vs. Milwaukee (2-1), at Minnesota (2-1), vs. San Diego (2-2), at New York-AL (1, 1-1), at Milwaukee (3) and vs. Seattle (3).

**GOLDY AND JOLTIN' JOE:** Cardinals first baseman **Paul Goldschmidt** is one home run from tying Hall of Famer and New York Yankees outfielder **Joe DiMaggio** for 86th place all-time in Major League history with 361 home runs. Goldschmidt hit No. 360 against the Padres and has been on a tear lately hitting safely in his last seven games (12-22, .545), leading all of MLB with a .545 BA over that period and ranks 2nd in hits (12) to **Oneil Cruz** (PIT) with 13. He posted a season-high with an RBI in five straight games (8/26-30), his longest streak since his MVP season in 2022.

**WHEN NOLAN GETS ROLLIN':** **Nolan Arenado** has hit safely in 14 straight games vs. the Yankees dating back to Flag Day in 2016 while with the Colorado Rockies. Arenado's streak is the longest among active players vs. the Bombers' and with seven straight as a Cardinal holds the longest regular season streak, and is tied **Tim McCarver** (7) and **Walker Cooper** (7) for 2nd-longest including the postseason. Only **Jim Bottomley** (8) has a longer streak, the three previous mentioned were accomplished for the Cardinals in World Series contests against the Yankees.

**WINN-ING ATTITUDE:** Cardinals rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn** is tied for the MLB lead (**Francisco Lindor**, NYM) with 23 hits since August 14 (.338, 23-68). Winn had a career-high four straight games with multiple hits during the San Diego series (8/26-29), longest streak by a Cardinals player this season.

**LONGBALL LORE:** Active Major Leaguers who have homered against every Major League team except the St. Louis Cardinals include **Aaron Judge** and **Gary Sanchez**. **Shohei Ohtani** recently achieved the feat on Aug. 17, 2024 at Busch Stadium.

- **Babe Ruth** has the most career home runs (714) of any player in MLB history to have never homered against the Cardinals in the regular season, however Ruth and **Carlos Beltran** share the MLB Postseason record of most homers against St. Louis during Postseason play with seven. Judge has the most career homers (308) among all active players without ever going yard against the Cardinals.
- **Matt Carpenter** (Cardinals & Twins) and **Joey Gallo** (Cardinals & Reds) are two active Major Leaguers to have homered against 28 teams but not St. Louis.
- **Juan Soto**, and **Giancarlo Stanton** are three of 22 active Major Leaguers to have homered against all 30 MLB teams. - *Elias*

#### NEW YORK YANKEES CONNECTIONS

**Willie McGee** was drafted by the Yankees in the 1st round (15th overall) of the 1977 MLB January Draft-Secondary Phase...played five minor league seasons in New York's organization before traded to St. Louis for LHP **Bob Sykes** (Oct. 21, 1981).

**Turner Ward** was originally selected by the Yankees in the 18th round of the 1986 MLB Draft...played three minor league seasons in the Yankee organization before traded to Cleveland for **Mel Hall** (March 19, 1989).

**Sonny Gray** pitched parts of two seasons with New York (2017-18) after being traded by Oakland with international bonus money for **Dustin Fowler**, **James Kaprielian**, and **Jorge Mateo** (July 31, 2017)...later traded by the Yankees with **Reiver Sanmartin** to Cincinnati for **Shed Long Jr.**, & 2019 competitive balance Rd A pick (Jan. 21, 2019).

**Matt Carpenter** aka "Matty Mustache" batted .305/.412/.727 with 15 HR and a 1.138 OPS in 47 games for the Yankees in 2022.

**Oliver Marmol** was born in nearby Elizabeth, NJ.

**Lance Lynn** made 18 starts for the Yankees in 2018 after being traded by Minnesota with cash for **Luis Rijo** and **Tyler Austin** (July 30, 2018).

**Aaron Boone** made his MLB debut at St. Louis on June 20, 1997 at Busch Stadium II (while with Cincinnati)...hit-game-winning RBI infield single off **Matt Morris** for first MLB hit that night...was ejected by HP umpire Gary Darling for throwing his helmet (was just the 4th player in Baseball history to be ejected in his MLB debut).

**Julio Rangel** pitched seven minor league seasons with the Yankees (1994-2000)...began coaching career with the High-A Tampa Yankees in 2001.

**Luke Weaver** was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (No. 27) of the 2014 MLB Draft...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged in a trade to Arizona for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018)...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** managed both the Cardinals (1990-95) and Yankees (1996-2007).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y....graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Cardinals Asst. GM **Moisés Rodriguez** is from the Lower East Side of Manhattan in New York City...formerly worked for MLB in New York (1998-2007).

Cardinals Manager, Player Development & Performance **Emily Wiebe** previously interned for the Yankees in Baseball Operations before joining St. Louis...graduated from Princeton Univ. in 2016.

Cardinals Manager, Baseball Info & Media Svcs. **Chris Tunno** previously served as a Yankees Baseball Operations Intern in Spring Training of 2002.

Cardinals Asst. Video Coordinator **Dan O'Connor** worked for the Yankees from 2014-20 in Baseball Operations as an intern, Minor League Video Manager, and Baseball Operations Assistant.

Bally Sports reporter **Jim Hayes** is a 1984 graduate of the State University College at Geneseo, N.Y....was born in Manhattan and raised in nearby Nyack in Rockland County.

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 28th start of the season and his 178th career (206th career appearance).
- Making his second career start vs. the Yankees, both coming at Yankee Stadium, but his first since July 21, 2014 (3,696 days).
- Leads MLB in first-pitch strike percentage (72.0%) this season, while his 67.1% career first-pitch strike percentage is tied with **Phil Hughes** (1291.0) for highest in MLB history among pitchers with 1,000 innings pitched.
- Sports the lowest Walk Pct. (4.7%) among active MLB pitchers (min. 500 innings).
- Has extensive home and road splits: 1-5 with a 5.97 ERA in 13 home starts and 7-5 with a 4.54 ERA in 14 road starts. The seven road wins rank T-2nd among N.L. pitchers.
- Seven (T-2nd in NL) of his eight wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, he has winning road record (34-29), but is just 24-27 at Busch Stadium. Ran off a streak of eight straight quality starts on the road before it was snapped in his 8/4 start at CHI, longest stretch of the season in MLB.
- Has thrown over 100 pitches in two of his 27 starts (101 at DET on 5/1 & 100 vs. LAD on 8/16) after ranking 7th in MLB with 12 such games in 2022. Ranks 2nd on the Cardinals with 2,316 pitches behind **Kyle Gibson** (2,221) and 21st in the National League.
- In his 167 starts w/ the Cardinals, St. Louis is 69-32 when Miles works 6.0+ IP (10-5 this season), while the Cardinals are 23-43 when he goes 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 48-7 (.872 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 64-16 in those 80 games - Cardinals 8-4 this season). He's just 11-52 (.175) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 28-59). Has received two runs of support or fewer in seven of his last 10 starts (2-4, 6.04 ERA, 53.2 IP).
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 5th among Major League pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018. **Erick Fedde** (.992) ranks 4th.
- Amassed 1,000 career innings in the National League in his Aug. 9 start, becoming the 17th active pitcher in MLB to record 1,000 innings as a member of the National League.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Received a no decision after departing the game in the 6th inning with a 5-4 lead. Received five runs of support, his most since his last win at home vs. SF (6/22) when he had seven runs backing.
- Surpassed 100 strikeouts in a season for the 5th time in his career.
