#### No Shortage at Shortstop

**Willy Adames** (30hr/101rbi) needs just 1 HR to tie his franchise record for homers in a season as a shortstop (31 in 2022)....he needs 12 RBI to tie **Robin Yount** (113 in 1982) for most RBI by a Brewer in a season at shortstop.

#### Action Jackson

In his last 77 games, **Jackson Chourio** has hit .315 (90-for-286) with 14 HR and 53 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .375 OBP/.549 SLG/.924 OPS.

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 42-28 at home, going 13-7-2 in series play....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks (5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28).

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 40-32 on the road, going 12-9-2 in series play....are 15-7 in their last 22 road games....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks (4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20).

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing **Craig Counsell**....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54)....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009)....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

**COACHES:** First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... **Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach), **Matt Erickson** (infield coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 39 replay challenges this season, going 23-16....their last challenge (lost) came on 9/6 vs. Colorado as an out call at third base involving Brewer Hicklen stood, ending the game.

# TODAY'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (28gs, 10-7, 3.75)

**PERALTA AT A GLANCE:** Freddy Peralta, 28, will be making his 29th start of the season and first against the Rockies.....Peralta last started last Monday vs. St. Louis and earned a 9-3 win (5.1ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 3k, 2hr, 102 pitches).....the team is 17-11 in his starts.....he has 11 quality starts.....opponents are batting .223 (126-for-566, 24hr)..... Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

**CAREER:** Is 52-34 with a 3.81 ERA and 1 save in 174 games/125 starts (734.1ip, 311r).....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-24).....has gone 44-32 with a 3.81 ERA as a starter (650.1ip, 275er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021.

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 31-18 with a 3.51 ERA in 93 games/65 starts (397.1ip, 155er).....is 6-4 with a 4.04 ERA in 15 starts this season (84.2ip, 38er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 21-16 with a 4.17 ERA in 81 games/60 starts (337ip, 156er).....is 4-3 with a 3.39 ERA in 13 starts this season (69ip, 26er).

**CAREER vs. ROCKIES:** Is 3-1 with a 3.41 ERA in 6 games/5 starts (29ip, 19h, 14r, 11er, 10bb, 48k, 6hr).....he has produced 10+ strikeouts in 3 of his 5 starts against Colorado (13, 10, 13).....went 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA in 2 starts against the Rockies last season (13ip, 8h, 3r, 3er, 3bb, 23k, 3hr).
