# PITTSBURGH PIRATES (62-72) vs. CLEVELAND GUARDIANS (77-58) AUGUST 31, 2024 AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD, CLEVELAND, OH - 6:10 EDT - GAME #135/ROAD #67 RHP LUIS ORTIZ (5-4, 3.36 ERA) vs. LHP MATTHEW BOYD (1-0, 2.70 ERA)

THE PIRATES: lost 10-8 last night in the opener of their three-game series against the Guardians...Have lost four straight and five of their last six games...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have played in 47 one-run games, which are the most in MLB (played 39 one-run games in all of 2023)...

Have the best stolen base percentage (86.1 percent) in MLB...Have recorded an extra base hit in a season-high 35 consecutive games (the fourth-longest active streak in all of MLB)...Are tied for sixth in MLB with 57 quality starts...Are hitting .337 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Royals (.384) Diamondbacks (.375) and Reds (.357).

**ON BASE WITH ONEIL:** Oneil Cruz has reached base safely in each of his last 21 games, which is the fourth-longest active streak in MLB behind Francisco Lindor (28 games), Yordan Alvarez (23 games) and Marcell Ozuna (23 games)...Cruz is hitting .367 (29-for-79) with eight doubles, one triple, one home run, 12 RBI and a .965 OPS since the streak began on August 7.

**CRUZING ALONG IN AUGUST:** Oneil Cruz comes into today first in the National League in batting (.385), second in on-base percentage (.447) and tied for third in doubles (nine) this month...Cruz .385 average is the highest by a Pirate (minimum 80 at-bats) during the month of August since Jay Bell hit .386 in 1993.

STREAKING CUTCH: Andrew McCutchen brings a season-high 12-game hitting streak into today, which is the second-longest active hitting streak in MLB (McCutchen also has a 13-game on-base streak)...McCutchen has gone 16-for-48 (.333) with two doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI and a

1.046 OPS during his current 12-game hitting streak...McCutchen's last single-season hitting streak of more than 12 games came in

2018 when he hit safely in 13 straight as a member of the Giants.

**CLEANING UP:** Andrew McCutchen recorded three RBI last night while hitting his first home run out of the cleanup spot since September 7, 2022, against the Rockies while playing for Milwaukee...The Pirates are tied for the 10th-most RBI (82) in MLB among cleanup hitters...Kansas City and San Diego lead with 100 RBI apiece out of the cleanup spot while Cleveland is third (99).

THE REYNOLDS REPORT: Bryan Reynolds comes into today one hit shy of 800 and three RBI away from 400 in his career...Since the beginning of June, Reynolds ranks ninth in all of MLB and third among National League players with a .312 average...The only two National League players with a higher average since the beginning of June are Jake McCarthy (.313) and Jackson Chourio (.312).

**GETTING ROWDY:** Rowdy Tellez went 2-for-3 with a home run on Friday and is now hitting .400 (10-for-25) with a double, two home runs and six RBI in his last seven games...Tellez is hitting at a .306 clip (64-for-209) in 67 games since the beginning of June.

**PIRATING:** Oneil Cruz has been successful in each of his last 17 attempts since being caught for the only time on April 22...The last Pirate to steal at least 17 consecutive bases without being caught in a single season is Nate McLouth (21 straight) from May 2 to September 28, 2008... Pittsburgh has stolen a base in each of its last five games and has 13 steals in its last 10 games...The last time a Pirates runner was caught stealing was on August 7...Pittsburgh's 86.1 percent stolen-base success rate leads MLB...Since 1951, the only seasons in which Pittsburgh led MLB in that category are 1979 and 1997.

ON THE OFFENSE: The Pirates have scored 50 runs since being shut out 1-0 on August 21 against the Rangers...Pittsburgh's 50 runs scored since August 22 are the third-most in all of MLB...The only two teams to score more runs during that time are the Cubs (80) and Brewers (57)...The Pirates have also hit a home run in each of their last six games (their season-high is eight straight games from June 18-26).

**ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER:** Luis Ortiz tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and was in line for the win but had a no-decision in his last start on Sunday against Cincinnati...He departed the game with a 2-0 lead before the Reds scored three times in the seventh... Yasmani Grandal then won it for the Pirates in the ninth inning with his two-run walkoff home run.

# **ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY**

August 31, 1971: The Pirates overcame a 5-0 deficit to beat the Phillies 7-5 on Pie Traynor Night at Three Rivers Stadium. Gene Clines delivered a pinch-hit, two-run double in the seventh while Manny Sanguillen followed with a two-run pinch-hit single of his own later in the inning to cap off Pittsburgh's comeback.

# TODAY'S STARTER RHP LUIS ORTIZ #48

# **2024 RECORD:** 5-4, 1 SAVE, 3.36 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-2/240 BATS/THROWS: R/R

**BORN:** January 27, 1999

AGE: 25 SIGNED: Thru 2024

HOW ACQUIRED: Signed by Pittsburgh as a non-drafted free agent on Oct. 2, 2018

**STARTING OFF:** The 25-year-old righthander is in his third Major League season, which have all come as a member of the Pirates...Entering today, he's made 54 career appearances (29 starts) for the Bucs, including 22 relief appearances in 2024 (10 starts)...He made the first Opening Day roster of his career with the Pirates in 2024 after making just two appearances (both starts) with the club in 2022 and 18 appearances (15 starts) over two stints with the Bucs in 2023...Ortiz was signed by the Pirates as an international free agent on October 2, 2018...He is one of four players to come up through the Pirates' Dominican Academy and reach the Major Leagues with the club, joining right-handed pitchers Yerry De Los Santos and Osvaldo Bido and infielder Rodolfo Castro.

**STARTING OFF:** Ortiz has posted a 2-2 record with a 3.26 ERA (58.0ip/21er), 43 strikeouts .201 batting average against as a starter this season.

- Dating back to his final start of the 2023 season until July 20, 2024, Ortiz threw 5.0-plus innings and allowed four or fewer hits in five consecutive starts, matching the second-longest such streak in club history...The only longer streak was six, accomplished by Francisco Liriano from July 17-August 14, 2014.
- He threw at least 5.0 innings, allowed five or fewer baserunners and one or zero runs in each of his first four starts this season...That tied Cliff Lee (2008), Trevor Bauer (2020), Corbin Burnes (2021) and Carlos Rodon (2022) for the longest streak of such starts to begin a season in the modern era (since 1901).

**FOR STARTERS:** Tonight will be Ortiz' 30th career Major League start and his 11th of the season

- Served in the bulk role following Carmen Mldozinski "opening" for the Bucs three times this season...Ortiz threw 4.1 shutout frames on June 8 vs. Minnesota, allowed one run in 5.0 innings on June 14 at Colorado and allowed six earned runs in 4.0 innings on June 21 vs. Tampa Bay.
- He started 67 of his 72 appearances in the minor leagues from 2019-2023.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ortiz tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and was in line for the win but had a no-decision on August 25 against the Reds...The Pirates won in walkoff fashion in the ninth inning when Yasmani Grandal hit a two-run home run off Alexis Diaz.

**<u>VS. CLEVELAND:</u>** Ortiz will make his first career appearance against the Guardians tonight.

**IN THE BEGINNING:** Ortiz has posted an 8.10 ERA (10.0ip/9er) in the first inning this season...Following the first inning, he has a 2.88 ERA (97.0ip/31er).

**2023 RECAP:** Ortiz had two different stints with the Pirates last season, going 4-5 with a 4.93 ERA (73.0ip/40er) in his 15 starts and 1-0 with a 3.95 ERA (13.2ip/6er) in three relief appearances.

 Pitched with the Dominican Republic team in the World Baseball Classic, making one appearances and striking out three batters in 2.0 scoreless innings.
