FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a six-game road trip with the second of a three game series against the New York Yankees this afternoon. The Cardinals and Yankees represent the World Series Championship leaders in each league with the Cardinals boasting 11 in the National League and the Yankees with 27 in the American League. The Cardinals defeated the Yankees in the 1926, 1942 and 1964 World Series and lost to them in 1928 and 1943. St. Louis entered today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 12.0 games back of Milwaukee and 7.0 games out of the 3rd Wild Card position

RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals lost to the Yankees 6-3 last night as Austin Wells hit two home runs for the Yankees accounting for four runs. Erick Fedde (8-8) struck out eight batters over 5.1 innings in the loss for the Cardinals. No-lan Arenado homered (#15) and extended his hitting streak against the Yankees to 13 games, while Paul Goldschmidt posted his third three hit game over the last four games.

FIVE-AND-DIMES: St. Louis has rapped out five straight games with double-digit hit totals, matching their season-high streak from July 4-8. The Cardinals 53 hits since Monday are tied for the Major League lead with the Chicago Cubs. Over those five games, the Cardinals are batting .299, 4th-highest in MLB. The last time the Cardinals collected double-digit hit totals in six straight games was May 17-23, 2022 (7 games).

**GOTTA BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST:** The Cardinals are 7-7 over their current 22-game stretch against playoff contending teams: vs. Los Angeles-NL (1-2), vs. Milwaukee (2-1), at Minnesota (2-1), vs. San Diego (2-2), at New York-AL (2, 0-1), at Milwaukee (3) and vs. Seattle (3).

**NEW YORK, NEW YORK...:** The St. Louis Cardinals are the only team in Major League Baseball who have not recorded a win at new Yankee Stadium. The Car-dinals last win in the Bronx came on October 12, 1964, when they defeated the Yankees 5-2 in Game 5 of the World Series. Tim McCarver's 10th inning three-run home run backed a 10-inning complete game behind Bob Gibson. Only former National League president Bill White (1B) and former Cardinals General Manager Dal Mayvill (2B) remain alive from Cardinals who played in that game Manager Dal Maxvill (2B) remain alive from Cardinals who played in that game.

A BRONX TALE: The Cardinals will play only their 5th regular season game at the new Yankee Stadium, fewest among visiting teams since the stadium opened in 2009 and their 2nd-fewest at any active stadium behind Globe Life Field (3 in 2023)

The Cardinals own the worst winning pct. (.000, 0-4) at Yankee Stadium, followed by the Pirates (.250, 1-4) and Cubs (.250, 2-6).

The Cardinals were 9-6 at Original Yankee Stadium in the Postseason. SIANI PLAYS NINE IN CENTER ON REHAB: Outfielder Michael Siani played the third game of his injury rehabilitation assignment for Springfield (AA) last night and was 0-for-1 with three walks, a stolen base and a run scored while playing nine innings in center field at Wichita.

**GOLDY AND JOLTIN' JOE:** Cardinals first baseman **Paul Goldschmidt** is one home run from tying Hall of Famer and New York Yankees outfielder **Joe DiMaggio** for 86th place all-time in Major League history with 361 home runs. Goldschmidt hit No. 360 against the Padres and has been on a tear lately hitting safely in his last six games (11-18, .611), leading all of MLB with 11 hits since Monday along with a season-high RBI in five straight games, his longest streak since his MVP season in 2022.

WHEN NOLAN GETS ROLLIN': Nolan Arenado has hit safely in 13 straight games vs. the Yankees dating back to Flag Day in 2016 while with the Colorado Rockies. Arenado's streak is the longest among active players vs. the Bombers' and with six straight as a Cardinal, is tied with Matt Carpenter (2014-17) for the longest by a Cardinals player in the regular season. Only **Jim Bottomley** (8), **Tim McCarver** (7) and **Walker** Cooper (7) have longer streaks, all accomplished for the Cardinals in World Series contests against the Yankees

WINN-ING ATTITUDE: Cardinals rookie shortstop Masyn Winn leads all of MLB with 23 hits since August 14 (.359, 23-64). Winn had a career-high four straight games with multiple hits during the San Diego series (8/26-29), longest streak by a Cardinals player this season. LONGBALL LORE: Active Major Leaguers who have homered against every Major League team except the St. Louis Cardinals include Aaron Judge and Gary Sanchez. Shohei Ohtani recently achieved the feat on Aug. 17, 2024 at Busch Stadium.

- Babe Ruth has the most career home runs (714) of any player in MLB history to have never homered against the Cardinals in the regular season, however Ruth and **Carlos Beltrán** share the MLB Postseason record of most homers against St. Louis during Postseason play with seven. Judge has the most career homers (308) among all active players without ever going yard against the Cardinals.
- Matt Carpenter (Cardinals & Twins) and Joey Gallo (Cardinals & Reds) are two active Major Leaguers to have homered against 28 teams but not St. Louis

Juan Soto, and Giancarlo Stanton are three of 22 active Major Leaguers to have homered against all 30 MLB teams. - Elias

- Making 26th start of the season and as a member of the Cardinals (320th career).
- Last started against the Yankees in 2023, both of his two starts as a member of the Orioles and most recently on July 4, 2023 in an 8-4 loss. Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball five weeks prior to that in a 3-1 Baltimore win.
- Durable starting pitcher has now logged 10 seasons of 20 or more starts since 2014, tied with teammate **Sonny Gray** for most in MLB (2014-19, 2021-24).
- Is 3-2 with a 3.68 in 10 day starts this season as opposed to 4-4 with a 5.16 ERA in 15 night starts. Home/Road splits are 2-4, 5.24 at Busch and 5-2, 3.88 on the road.
- Needs two more wins to tie Stephen Strasburg (113) for the most wins of any pitcher from the MLB 2009 draft class. Has the 3rd-most wins of any Minnesota Twins first round draft picks with 111 (Tim Belcher 146, Dick Ruthven 123).
- Limited his opposition to two earned runs or fewer in 13-of-25 starts, tied 2nd for among Cardinals starters with **Sonny Gray** (13) behind **Erick Fedde** (17).
- Boasts a 42.5% Whiff Pct. on Sweepers, 2nd-highest for the Sweeper (Gray, STL, 43.6%) among MLB starting pitchers.
- Is 13 strikeouts shy of 1,500 for his career. Has had 100+ K's in each of his 10 full seasons played including this year (126).
- Five of his starts have been delayed by rain (5 hr. 14 min. total) and he was scratched from his scheduled start on 6/19 at MIA during warm-ups due to back tightness.
- Has started four doubleheader games this season (April 30-1 at Detroit; June 26-1 vs. Atlanta; June 13-2 vs. Chicago Cubs; July 20-1 at Atlanta), most by a Cardinal since Daniel Ponce de Leon (4 in 2020) and most in a non-COVID-19 affected season since Bob Forsch (4 in 1983). - Elias
- St. Louis area resident and Univ. of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November. Is one of three free-agent starters (Sonny Gray & Lance Lynn) that the Cardinals signed last off-season. Pitching for his fifth MLB team: Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).
