FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals and visiting San Diego Padres play the third game of a four-game series tonight at Busch Stadium . The Cardinals entered today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 10.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and 7.0 games back of Atlanta for the 3rd Wild Card spot.

GOTTA BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST: The Cardinals are 5-6 over their current 22-game stretch against playoff contending teams: vs. LA Dodgers (1-2), vs. Brewers (2-1), at Twins (2-1), vs. Padres (0-2), at NY Yankees (3g), at Brewers (3g) and vs. Mariners (3g).

WHO'S YOUR PADRE: The Cardinals all-time .664 (170-87) home win pct. in St. Louis over the Padres (1969-present) is the 3rd-highest by one home team vs. any visitor in MLB history. - Elias

- Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals .678 home win pct. (40-19) vs. the Friars is their 2nd-best against any visitor behind only Colorado (.734, 47-17).
- The Cardinals all-time .585 (300-213) win percentage over the Padres (1969-present) is their 5th-best against any opponent, while no NL team has higher all-time win pct. over San Diego than St. Louis.

YO JOE: In 33 career plate appearances against starter Joe Musurove. Paul Goldschmidt is batting .500/.636/.708 (12-24) with 1 home run, nine walks, and a 1.345 OPS, with his 12 hits off Musgrove representing the most by any MLB hitter ... Nolan Arenado is batting .462/.429/.538 (6-13) with a .967 OPS, while Lars Nootbaar has homered and walked in his only two plate appearances off Musgrove.

GOLDY, JOLTIN' JOE, & DUCKY: With his next home run, Paul Goldschmidt will tie Joe DiMaggio (361 HR) for 86th all-time in MLB history (361 HR) and also match Joe Medwick (152 HR) for 14th in franchise history ... Last night, Goldy recorded his 11th season with 20 or more home runs, 2nd among active players behind Giancarlo Stanton (13 seasons).

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR CANDIDATES: San Diego's Jackson Merrill leads or shares the Major League rookie lead in hits (134), homers (19), batting average (.292), slugging (.490), OPS (.813), total bases (225), and extra-base hits (47), while Masyn Winn paces MLB rookies in defensive bWAR (2.2), position player bWAR (4.6), multi-hit games (39), plate appearances (512), and atbats (468), and ranks 2nd in batting average (.284), hits (133), times on base (169), and total bases (198).

• Winn is aiming to become the first Cardinals rookie to lead his team in hits since 2001 NL Rookie of the Year Albert Pujols (194) and also lead all MLB rookies in hits since 1985 NL Rookie of the Year Vince Coleman (170) ... The last Cardinal to do both was Rogers Hornsby (155 hits in 1916). - Elias

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS: The Cardinals have played 88 games decided by three runs or fewer this season, 2nd-most in MLB to Tampa Bay (89) ... St. Louis sports a 2.72 run differential per game in wins, 2nd-lowest in MLB to the Rays (2.65).

MATHEWS PROMOTED TO MEMPHIS (AAA): The Cardinals announced today that No. 3 prospect (No. 60 in Top 100) LHP Quinn Mathews was promoted to Memphis (AAA) ... The 23-year-old Mathews, who was selected by the Cardinals in the 4th round out of Stanford in 2023, leads all of Minor League baseball in strikeouts (180) over his 126.2 innings pitched between Palm Beach (A), Peoria (A+), and Springfield (AA) ... The Cardinals minor league single-season strikeout record is held by Rick Ankiel, who fanned 222 hitters over 161.0 innings in his first professional season in 1998 at 18 years old between Single-A and High-A.

## Fernando Tatis, father of Padres outfielder, Fer**nando Tatís Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for

hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**. Paul Goldschmidt's cousin. Dan Dallas, was se-

lected by the Padres in the 7th round of the 2016 MLB Draft...played four minor league seasons in the Padres minor league organization (2016-19).

Miles Mikolas was selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB draft...pitched parts of two seasons with the Padres (2012-13), where he made his MLB debut...traded by San Diego with Jaff Decker to Pittsburgh for Alex Dickerson (Nov. 25, 2013).

Matt Carpenter played in 76 games for San Diego

Tommy Pham played two seasons for San Diego (2020-21)...Traded by Tampa Bay with **Jake**Cronenworth to the Padres for Esteban Quiroz, Xavier Edwards, & Hunter Renfroe (Dec. 6, 2019).

Padres Hitting Coach Victor Rodríguez played two minor league seasons (1986-87) for the Louisville Redbirds (AAA) in the Cardinals organization.

David Peralta was originally signed by St. Louis as an International free agent pitcher (Sept. 26, 2004)...pitched three minor league seasons (2005-07) before transitioning to the outfield...underwent two left-shoulder surgeries...released in May 2009.

#### **SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS**

Mike Shildt coached and managed parts of 18 seasons in the Cardinals organization (2004served as area scout (2004-07) and coach (2005-08) before transitioning to minor league manager (2009-16)...Joined St. Louis coaching staff in 2017 and was Cardinals manager for parts of four seasons (2018-21)...led Cardinals to three postseason berths...2019 NL Manager of the Year.

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach Mike McCoy was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Donovan Solano played seven minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2005-11).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Mark McGwire was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Padres Catching Coach Brian Esposito played parts of two seasons for Memphis (AAA) in 2006-07 and one game for St. Louis in 2007.

Hall of Famer Ozzie Smith was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft... played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)... traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Athletic reporter Katie Woo spent the 2018 MLB season covering the Padres as an associate reporter for MLB.com.

Padres Coach Peter Summerville's brother, An**drew**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres broadcaster Carlos Hernandez played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with **Nate Tebbs** from the Padres for Heathcliff Slocumb and current Memphis (AAA) manager Ben Johnson.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor Allen Craig played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for Woody Williams (Aug. 2, 2001).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played part of the 2008 season for San Diego (26 games)... traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter Daniel Guerrero graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

Cardenales broadcaster Polo Ascencio was born in nearby Tijuana, Mexico...considers Padres Eduardo Ortega as a broadcasting mentor.

#### TONIGHT'S GAME

- Making his 15th start of the season tonight and his 25th career. His first career start vs.
   San Diego after five relief appearances.
- Is 2-0 in three career relief appearances vs. the Padres at Busch Stadium. Tied for his 2nd-most wins against any opponent (CIN 5-0, COL 2-0).
- Has a career mark of 7-0 against National League West opponents, the 2nd-most wins involving a perfect winning record in MLB history with 25 or more games pitched, behind only Jean Machi (9-0) from 2012-15.
- Posted back-to-back starts of 7.0 innings or more against the Dodgers (8/17) and at the Twins (8/23).
- Began the season in the bullpen and was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine relief appearances, getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21.
- Was recalled on May 26 and has made 14 starts since, posting the lowest ERA (3.52) among Cardinals starters since then, the 8th best ERA in the National League. Pirates rookie Paul Skenes leading the list with a 2.15 ERA.
- Won his first three home starts (3-0, 2.87 ERA, 15.2 IP) this season, then lost three (0-3, 6.75 ERA, 16.0 IP) before he won last week, recording a decision in all seven.
- Despite being winless in his four July starts, owned the Cardinals top starter's ERA (3.33) for the month and his .220 opponent's BA in July ranked 9th among N.L. starters.
- Has received three runs of support or less in 10-of-14 starts this season including 7 straight from June 28 to Aug. 10. Is 5-1 in his five starts when receiving 3+ runs.
- Was involved in the decision in his first six starts this and in 10 of 13 starts overall.
- His career reverse splits have continued this season, as he's held LHB to .210 BA & .557
  OPS, while RHB are batting .269 with .740 OPS, hitting 4 of the 6 HR's he's allowed in
  2024.
- Had his 17.0 IP scoreless innings streak as a starter snapped in an 8-5 defeat at HOU (6/4), pitched 3.0 innings allowing six runs.
- The scoreless inning streak had dated back to the 1st inning (3 runs allowed) of his 7/26/22 start at Toronto. Blanked Washington for 8.0 IP in 7/31/22 start at Nationals Park, followed by 6.0 scoreless IP in start at CIN (5/29/24).
- Is 9-8, 3.71 ERA in 24 career starts (124.0 IP/53 ER) and 7-4 with a 3.90 ERA in 108 career relief appearances (131.2 IP/57 ER).
- Was recalled on May 26 from Memphis (AAA), and made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington at Great American Ball Park vs. CIN (5/29).
- Appeared in four games (three starts) in Memphis (AAA) after being optioned from St. Louis on April 21, going 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP), 13 walks, nine strikeouts, and a 1.65 WHIP
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 104 at KC on (8/10/24).

#### LAST TIME OUT

• Stranded several runners in the first two innings helped by a double play then didn't allow a base runner after the 3rd inning. Tied his season-high and has thrown 7.0 innings in consecutive starts for the first time this season allowing just one run.

- The Southern California native is making his first career start and sixth appearance against the Padres.
- Is 2-0 at Busch Stadium earning a win in his first career appearance, coming in after Packy Naughton pitched 2.1 innings as an opener.
- His two wins vs. SD are T-2nd most against any opponent (CIN 5-0, COL 2-0).
- Is a career 7-0 against N.L. West teams, one of two pitchers in MLB history with 7 or more wins with a perfect 1.000 win percentage with 25 or more appearances joining Jean Machi (9-0) from 2012-15.

#### 2024

- Began the season in the bullpen and was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine relief appearances, getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21. Was recalled on May 26 and has made 13 starts since, posting the lowest ERA (3.75) among Cardinals starters and 15th lowest ERA in the National League.
- Made his first MLB start since 2022 at CIN (5/29), threw 6.0 scoreless innings at Great American Ball Park for a 5-3 win. Threw a then season-high 86 pitches (both Memphis & St. Louis) and did not allow a hit until the 4th inning.
- Made his second career appearance in a neutral site game when he started vs. SF (6/20) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala. Joined Alan Benes (4/19/1997 vs. SD) as the only two Cardinals starting pitchers to earn a win at a neutral site game.
- Logged a season-high 7.0 IP at PIT (7/4). His longest outing since a career-high 8.0 IP at WSH (7/31/22). Tossed a then career-high 101 pitches in his final start before the All-Star break in Game 1 of 7/10/24 split DH vs. KC.
