- UC Berkeley currently hosts **4,548** international students (not including students at Summer Session or UC Extension).
- In Fall 2011, **1,688** students began a new program of study.
- **56.24** % of all students are undergraduate level.
- 43.76 % of all students are graduate level.
- Berkeley International Office also serves an additional 565 international students on Optional Practical Training and Academic Training.
- In 2011, **2,193** students on F and J visas attended Summer Session.


