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Fall 2013 Summary

- UC Berkeley currently hosts **5,645** international students from **120** different nations (not including students at Summer Session or UC Extension).
- In 2013, **2,415** students on F and J visas attended Summer Session.
- In 2013, **127** additional students attended the Masters of Law (LLM) summer program.
- In Fall 2013, **2,039** students began a new program of study.
- **61.22%** of all students are undergraduate level.
- **38.78%** of all students are graduate level.
- Berkeley International Office also serves an additional **944** international students on Optional Practical Training and Academic Training.

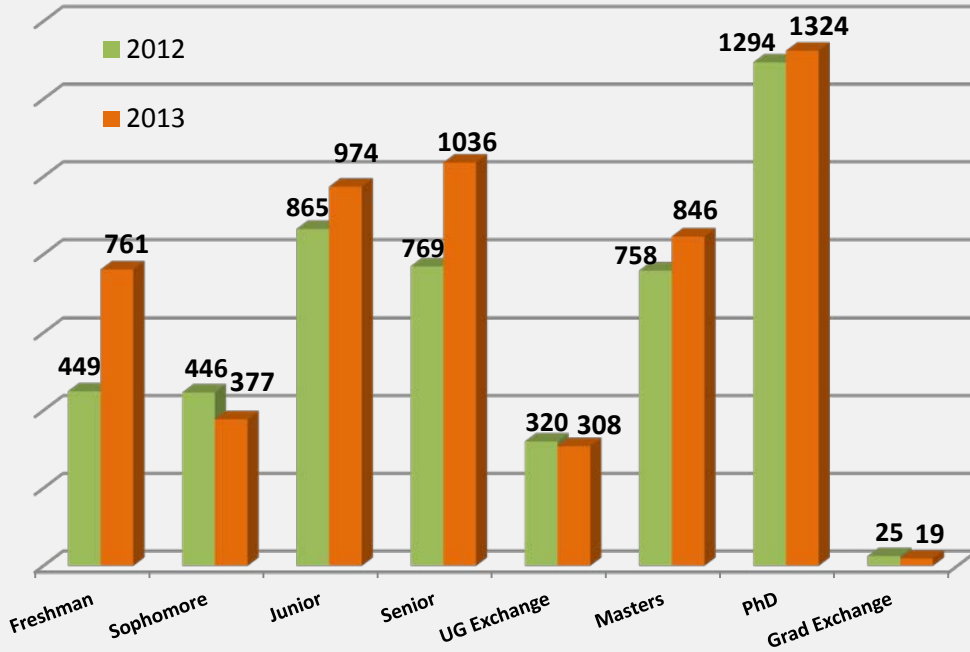

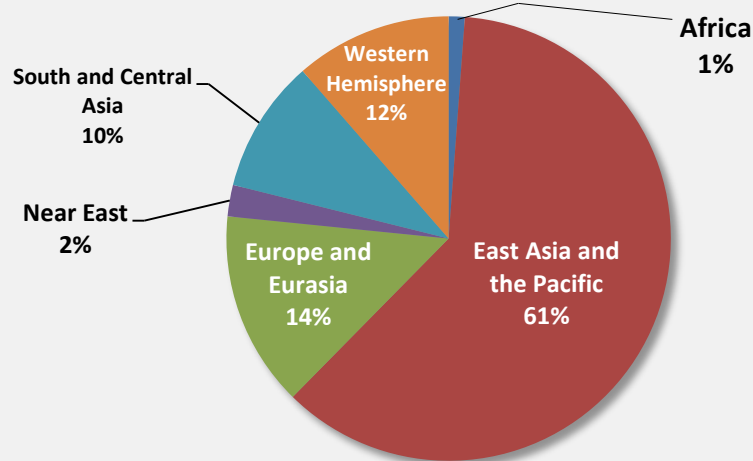
Educational Level Fall 2012 vs. 2013



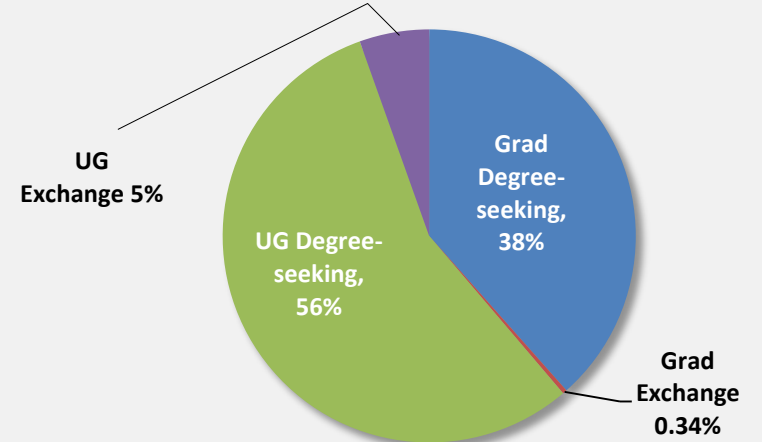

Percentage Graduate vs. Undergraduate

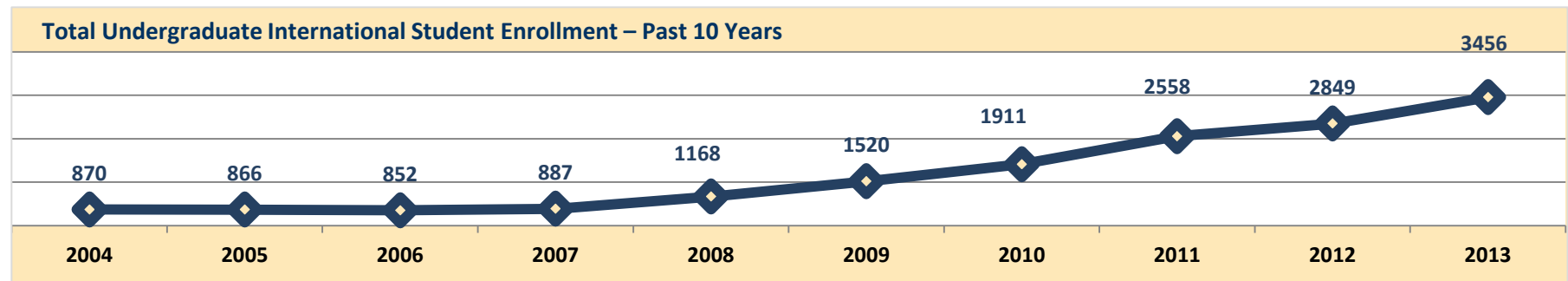
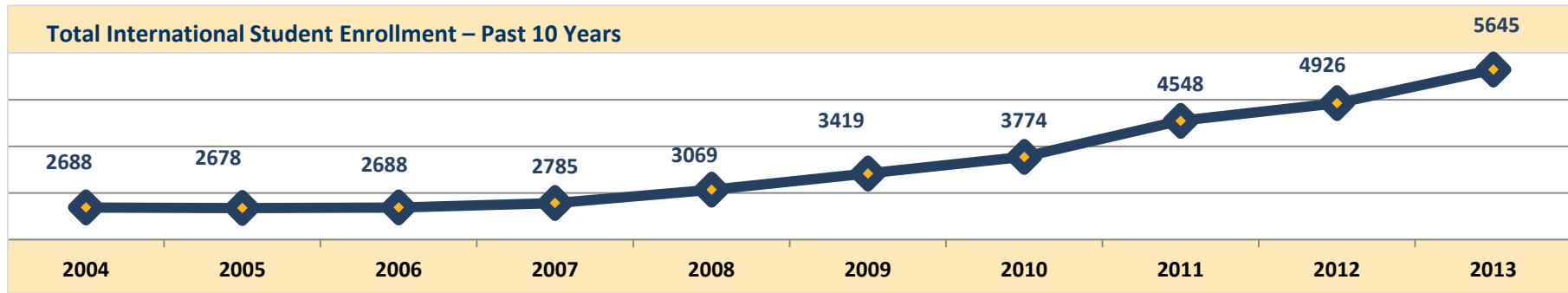
