Occupational Guides: Detailed information on wages, job outlook, education, and licensing requirements for approximately 800 occupations.

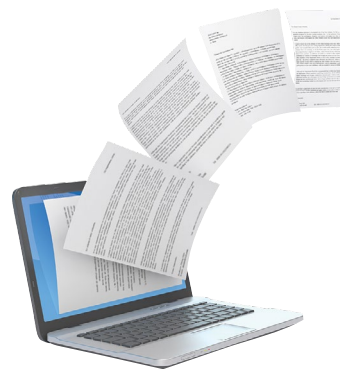
Monthly Data Release: Revised and preliminary civilian labor force, unemployment rates, and industry employment data for California, metropolitan areas, counties, and sub-county areas.
