Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$54,766 cash funds from the Marijuana Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue for FY 2018-19 and \$2,728,795 cash funds from the Marijuana Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue for FY 2019-20. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.2 FTE in FY 2018-19 and an additional 15.5 FTE in FY 2019-20.

The provision reappropriates to the Department of Law \$31,089 in FY 2018-19 and \$242,494 in FY 2019-20. This provision also states that based on the appropriations the Department of Law will require an additional 0.2 FTE in FY 2018-19 and an additional 1.3 FTE in FY 2019-20.

The provision reappropriates \$18,772 to the Department of Public Safety in FY 2019-20 for
