How to... Receive Hearing Notices by Email


You can ask the Hawaii State Legislature's website to alert you when a particular measure gets scheduled for a hearing, or when selected committees convene.

It's a great way to make sure you don't miss an important opportunity to offer testimony.


 Go to the Legislature's website (capitol.hawaii.gov), click on "Log In" (upper right corner) and enter your email address and password. *



2. Either click on "Hearing Notification" or select it using the drop-down menu under the "Participate" tab.




3. This form appears.

^{*} If this is your first time using the interactive features of the website, you'll have to **Register**. Click on "Register" (upper right corner of the page) and enter your name, email address, and the password you'd like to use for the website. After you've agreed to the terms and conditions, you will be directed to access your email account and open the email sent to you by the website. Follow the instructions for confirming your account. You'll only be asked to do this once. After that, just log in and enter your password.

4. Select the hearing notices you'd like to receive.



5. When done, **click the "Save and Exit" button** centered near the top of the page. It's easy to come back anytime, log in again, and change your selections.

As soon as any of the requested hearing notices are posted, they will be sent to you by email.
