ORDER

A hearing was held in this matter on December 14, 2006, the Honorable Jenny Lee Kronk, Little Traverse Bay Bands (LTBB) of Odawa Indians Associate Judge, presiding. Present at the hearing were Roland M. Petoskey, plaintiff, Stephen B. Graham, Jr., attorney for the plaintiff, and Regina Bentley, defendant.

Findings of Fact

Mr. Petoskey testified that he does not dislike or hate Regina Bentley. He knows there have been problems in the past but hopes each can go their own way. However, he would like his daughter to be able to call and talk to him or visit him if she likes. After Mr. Petoskey's testimony, Mr. Graham advised the court that he did not think a no-contact order was appropriate at this time.

Conclusions of Law

Given Mr. Petoskey's wishes, a no-contact order will not be issued. The Court would hope that the parties and their families will be able to respect one another and not do or say anything that would be hurtful or harmful to one another.

Therefore, it is ORDERED that plaintiff's motion is denied.
