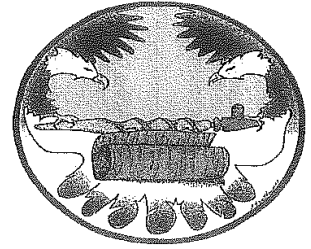

FOREIGN JUDGMENT - ORDER FOLLOWING OBJECTION HEARING

The Court, having set this matter for a hearing on December 22, 2008 where respondent did appear, finds:

- 1) A foreign judgment, Case Number 08-0854-GC of the 90th District Court, was filed on December 02, 2008 for recognition by this Court;
- 2) *Notice of Registration* was served on the Respondent on December 02, 2008 by first-class mail notifying the Respondent that this *Order* would be entered unless a written objection was filed within twenty-one (21) days as set forth in Little Traverse Bay Bands Court Rules 4.303;
- 3) The Respondent filed a written objection on December 5, 2008;
- 4) Respondent's objection was to the judgment since Little Traverse Bay Bands Contract Health referred the Respondent and provided a reference number, which usually means that the bill is paid by the contract health program;
- 5) The Petitioner's attorney, Mr. Beck, explained the process and how it became filed in Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Court;
- 6) The Court explained foreign judgments and Court Rule 4.303 to the Respondent with an explanation of why the recognition of the judgment would be ordered; and
- 7) The Respondent will take a copy of the bill to Contract Health and request payment but if payment is denied then Respondent will make a payment of \$500.00 to Petitioner's attorney, Mr. Beck, and provide the Court with documentation;

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that recognition be given to the 90th District Court judgment.
