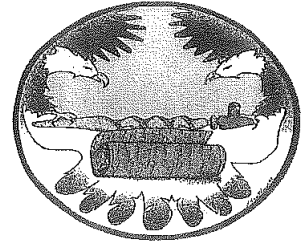

FOREIGN JUDGMENT - ORDER FOLLOWING OBJECTION HEARING

The Court, having set this matter for a hearing on June 6, 2011 where respondent did appear, finds:

- 1) A foreign judgment, Case Number 10-1666-GC of the 90th District Court, was filed on April 4, 2011 for recognition by this Court;
- 2) *Notice of Registration* was served on the Respondent on April 5, 2011 by first-class mail notifying the Respondent that this *Order* would be entered unless a written objection was filed within twenty-one (21) days as set forth in Little Traverse Bay Bands Court Rules 4.303;
- 3) The Respondent filed a written objection on April 18, 2011;
- 4) Respondent's objection was to the amount of the judgment because of Respondent's personal financial situation. Respondent may have an outside source that may possibly be able to assist Respondent with repayment;
- 5) Petitioner's attorney, Mr. Beck, explained the process to date and that additional legal documents were needed to determine repayment of the judgment;
- 6) The Court explained foreign judgments and Court Rule 4.303 to the Respondent with an explanation of why the recognition of the judgment would be ordered; and
- 7) Respondent explained that her mother has been responsible for her finances. Respondent's mother provided Mr. Beck's office with several financial documents. It was clarified during the hearing what additional legal documents are needed by Mr. Beck. Respondent agreed to provide the necessary documents.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that recognition be given to the 90th District Court judgment.
