
This Court conducted a hearing on August 10, 2004, Respondent's Petition to Re-instate Treaty Privileges.

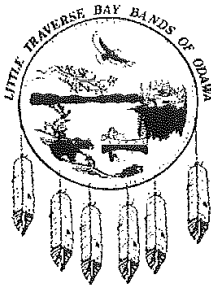
Respondent now acknowledges his duty to file monthly catch reports and to keep the Conservation Department apprised of his current address.

HEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Defendant's LTBB Natural Resources privileges and licenses be revoked.
2. Defendant is not eligible for reinstatement of privileges or licenses until eligibility is established by this Court.
3. Defendant must petition the Court for reinstatement of LTBB Natural Resources privileges.
4. Privileges will not be reinstated until the fine and costs due in this matter are paid in full.
5. Defendant must pay a filing fee of \$ 50.00 to petition the Court for reinstatement of privileges and licenses.



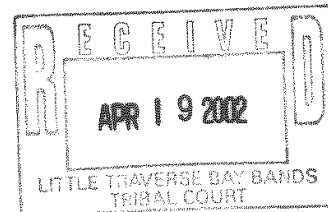

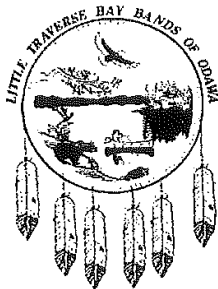
AMENDED DEFAULT JUDGMENT

1. A *Default Judgment* was entered by this Court on December 13, 2001 and Defendant was given thirty (30) days to pay the fine and court costs.
2. The mailing was returned to this Court on January 2, 2002.
3. The Court has obtained a new address for Defendant from other tribal records.
4. Notice of the Default Judgment shall be mailed to the new address and Defendant given until March 1, 2002 to pay the outstanding fine and court costs.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

NOTE TO DEFENDANT:

If you fail to pay, the Court will REVOKE your LTBB Natural Resources privileges and you will be required to petition the Court for reinstatement of your LTBB Natural Resources privileges. Once privileges are revoked, they will not be reinstated until the fine and costs are paid in full AND you will be required to petition the Court for reinstatement of treaty privileges. You will also have to pay a filing fee of \$ 50.00 when you file the petition.
