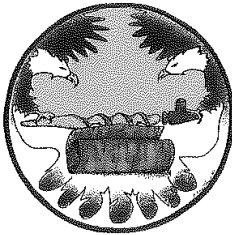

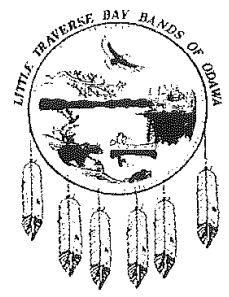

Defendant did not pay the outstanding fine and court costs in this matter by January 14, 2003 as ordered by this Court on December 20, 2002.

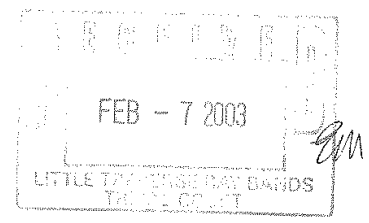
WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

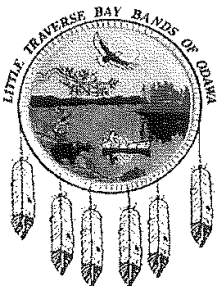

2. Return this notice with a certified check or money order in the amount of the judgment by January 14, 2003 by 5:00pm.

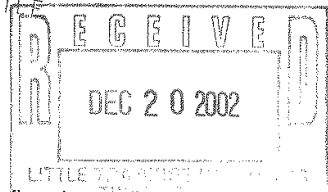
