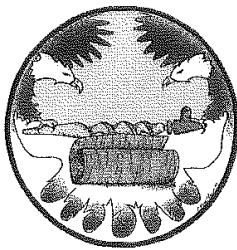

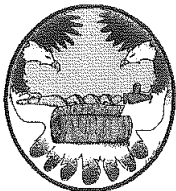
This Court conducted a Show Cause Hearing on May 08, 2008. The Respondent, Richard Damien Feathers, Sr., failed to satisfy the *Default Judgment* against him on March 31, 2008. Mr. Feathers, Sr. failed to respond to the Plea by Mail, failed to attend the Show Cause Hearing on Plea by Mail, and failed to satisfy the *Default Judgment*. The Respondent has not contacted the Court in regards to this matter.

This Court finds Mr. Richard Damien Feathers, Sr. in Contempt of Court for failure to pay the *Default Judgment* fine and court costs on time. The Court imposes a contempt fine of Twenty-Five dollars (\$25.00) and costs in the amount of Twenty-Five dollars (\$25.00).

WHEREFORE, IT IS SO ORDERED that Respondents LTBB Natural Resources privileges are hereby revoked. Respondent has six months (6 months) to pay both judgments against him. The total amount due to the Court is One Hundred dollars (\$100.00). Should respondent fail to pay both judgments against him by November 08, 2008, a bench warrant for failure to comply with the Court Order will be issued.



DEFAULT JUDGMENT

If you fail to pay, the Court will schedule a SHOW CAUSE HEARING for you to show cause why you should not be held in contempt of court for not paying the fine and court costs on time. If you are found to be in contempt of court, the court may REVOKE your LTBB Natural Resources privileges. They will not be reinstated until the fine and costs are paid in full.
