## TRIBAL RESOLUTION #0XXX22-01

Use of Third-Party Support Revenue in the Amount of \$550,000 to Fund the Start-Up

Expenses of a Medicaid-Only Clinic

- WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance; and
- WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (LTBB) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States, the most recent of which is the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621); and
- WHEREAS the LTBB Constitution states the Directive Principle: "Promote with special care the health, educational, and economic interests of all the people, especially our children and elders [...];" and
- WHEREAS there is a critical need within the LTBB Community for the delivery of medical services to underserved Medicaid-eligible community members; and
- WHEREAS third-party billing revenue received from offering additional Medicaid supportive services is a viable method of generating funding to sustain and expand LTBB health services to further support the wellbeing of the LTBB community;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council appropriates \$550,000 from third-party billing revenue to be used to fund the start-up expenses of a Medicaid-only Clinic.

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED** that in accordance with the Constitution, the Executive Branch shall administer such funds as appropriated by Tribal Council.
