3	TRIBAL GOVERNMENT BUDGET STATUTE
4

6	
7	SECTION I. PURPOSE AND SHORT TITLE
8	
9	The purpose of this statute, which may be cited as the "Budget Act," is to mandate a process
10	and deadlines for the government of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians to follow
11	in the formulation and implementation of its annual budget. This statute repeals and replaces
12	Waganakising Odawak Statute 2020-006 and any previous Statute, Resolution Regulation or
13	Policy language with regard to the same.
14	
15	
16	SECTION II. DEFINITIONS
17	
18	A. "Chief Financial Officer" or "CFO" is the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians
19	tribal government Chief Financial Officer.
20	
21	B. "Committee" means the Tribal Council standing Appropriation and Finance
22	Committee consisting of the Treasurer and two Councilors.
23	
24	C. "Fringe Benefits" means the non-wage expenses for the benefit of employees that
25	includes, but is not limited to, Health, Dental and Vision Insurance, Disability Insurance,
26	Unemployment Benefits, Worker's Compensation Insurance and Employer-Portion of FICA
27	Insurance.
28	D (F 19)
29	<b>D.</b> "Fund" means a segregated, self-balancing account used to record revenues,
30	expenditures, assets, liabilities and other financial transactions for a specific purpose, activity
31	or objective.
32	E "Fund tyme" for the numerous of this statute means for de distinguished by the manifest
33	E. "Fund type" for the purposes of this statute means funds distinguished by the monies
34	or revenue source, i.e. Grant/Federal Contract Funds, Cost recovery, and General Fund.

- 1 **F.** "General Fund Balance" also known as "Prior Period funds" means the prior years'
- 2 unrestricted general fund dollars that were budgeted but not expended in the year they were
- 3 budgeted and that are returned to the general fund unrestricted balance available for
- 4 appropriation in subsequent years.

5

- 6 G. "Governmental Branches" mean the Legislative, Executive and Judiciary branches of
- 7 LTBB and, for the purposes of this statute, shall also include the Election Board and
- 8 Prosecutor.

9

- 10 H. "Indirect Costs" means the expenses that are incurred in joint usage of internally
- servicing a government program and are not directly assigned or identify with a direct program
- or function, such as Accounting, Human Resources, and Administration.

- 14 I. "Indirect Cost Rate" means the formula used by United States Department of the
- 15 Interior that pools all of the indirect costs on an annual basis through an allocable, approved
- 16 plan.

17

- 18 **J.** "Maintenance or Space Costs" means the costs of all the government office building
- 19 upkeep, allocated on a square foot basis. Costs include the wages and fringe of maintenance
- staff, cleaning and maintenance supplies and equipment, repairs made for regular upkeep, snow
- 21 removal and lawn care, and utilities, including telephone and internet service.

22

- 23 K. "LTBB" or "Tribe" or "Tribal" means the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa
- 24 Indians.

25

- 26 L. "Tribal-wide Budget Worksheet" means the worksheet that lists governmental
- 27 departments and individual programs, i.e. Emergency funds, Burial Assistance funds, that is
- attached to the Resolution and it becomes the approved budget for that fiscal year

- 30 M. "Tribal Council" means the elected body created under Article VII of the Little
- 31 Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Constitution.

32

- $\mathbf{N}.$  "Treasurer" means the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Treasurer as
- 34 provided for in the Constitution.

7	annual meeting of the Tribal Membership each spring. The date of the annual meeting will be		
8	provided to Tribal Council and included in the Annual Budget Calendar.

13	Each year, by February 1st, the CFO shall distribute to Department Managers, Department		
14	Directors, and the Branch Managers or other appropriate authorized staff, the Budge

28	SECTION VII. GENERAL FUND REVENUES ANNUAL BUDGET		
29	SECTION VII. GENERAL FUND REVENUES ANNUAL BUDGET		
30	<b>A.</b> Any unrestricted general fund dollars that were budgeted but not expended in the year		
31	they were budgeted shall automatically be returned to the general fund unrestricted balance,		
32	known as the "General Fund Balance", unless otherwise approved by Tribal Council. General		
33	Fund Revenues are the unrestricted monies received by the Tribal Government from		
34	enterprises and other sources. For Budget purposes the General Fund includes the current year		
35	anticipated revenue, any remaining unrestricted funds from prior years known as the General		

- Fund Balance and any funds that have been restricted as Supplemental Funding but are
- 2 unspent. Each year, by **February 1st**, the Office of the Treasury, with information and
- 3 assistance from the Accounting Department, shall report to Tribal Council the General Fund
- 4 Amounts that include approximate amount of the "General Fund Balance" and the anticipated
- 5 amount of revenue that may be utilized to formulate the budget.

6

- 7 **B.** Each year, by **February 15th**, Tribal Council shall approve the Governmental
- 8 Branches allocation amounts of general funds that each branch of government may utilize for
- 9 their base budget for the following Fiscal Year.

10

- 11 C. The allocated amounts of general funds will be based on anticipated revenues,
- anticipated outlays, available funds and historical numbers for the last three (3) years of actual
- spending by Governmental Branches.

- 15 **D.** Tribal Council may also, by Tribal Resolution, allocate and restrict any anticipated
- 16 revenue, any remaining unrestricted funds from prior years known as the General Fund
- 17 Balance and any funds that have been restricted as Supplemental Funding, but are unspent
- from the prior year to be set aside for the proposed Governmental Branches budgets.

#### SECTION VIII. COST RECOVERY FUND ANNUAL BUDGET

22

- 23 A. Cost Recovery Revenues include Fringe Benefits, Maintenance, Indirect Costs and
- 24 other restricted revenues.

**B.** The budget shall be based on anticipated Cost Recovery Revenues in the year being planned, current fund balance for the Cost Recovery Pool, anticipated outlays, and historical numbers for the last three (3) years of actual spending by Governmental Branches.

### SECTION IX. GRANT/FEDERAL CONTRACT BUDGET

- 33 A. Grant/Federal Contract Revenues are recurring or anticipated monies that are received
- 34 by the Tribe that includes but not limited to Indian Health Services, IHS; Bureau of Indian
- 35 Affairs, BIA 638; Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act,
- NAHASDA; and any other reasonably anticipated funds.

2	<b>B.</b> Tribal Council shall approve the Grant/Federal Contract Revenues budget as part of the		
3	Tribal-wide budget by the annual meeting.

6	SECTION X	K. BUDGET SUBMISSIONS	
7			
8	A. All p	proposed Governmental Branches budgets whether utilizing General Fund	
9	Revenues, G	Grant/Federal Contract Revenues shall be submitted to Legislative Office by	
10	March 15th	of each year. Such budgets shall be made available to the Chief Financial Officer.	
11			
12	1.	If there is a deletion of any program or service, a justification as to why the	
13		program or service is no longer needed or not sustainable shall be provided with	
14		the proposed budget by the Branch of Government.	
15			
16	2.	If there are any additions to program or service, a justification as to why the	
17		program or service is necessary shall be provided with the proposed budget by	
18		the Branch of Government.

21		Governmental Branch budgets. If there is any deletions or additions, Tribal	
22	Council shall	notify the appropriate entity after all public hearings have been conducted.

1 **D.** Any Department Managers, Department Directors, and the Branch Managers or other appropriate authorized staff may request a time for a Governmental Branch hearing.

4 **E.** All Governmental Branch hearings shall be held during the first full week of April.

6 **F.** A Public hearing for Tribal Citizenship input shall be held during the second full week of April. At the Public hearing, copies of the draft budget will be provided to the Tribal

#### SECTION XII. APPROVAL PROCESS

12

13 **1.** Tribal Council shall approve the annual budget by the annual meeting.

14

The annual budget shall be approved by Tribal Resolution and shall include an attached detailed worksheet of the tribal-wide budget.

The Tribal Council approved budget shall be available for Tribal Citizens at the Annual
Meeting, in accordance with the Constitution.

20

21 **4.** The budget shall be deemed enacted if not expressly vetoed by the Tribal Chair within 22 thirty (30) days of submission.

23

5. If the Chair vetoes the budget, then he or she must submit an Executive proposed signed Tribal Resolution and new proposed budget along with the veto to Tribal Council within the thirty (30) day time period allowed for the veto.

27

28 **6.** The Chair's veto and proposed budget must be made available to Tribal Citizens and posted to the Tribe's website.

- 7. Tribal Council may enact a budget by either overriding the veto by an affirmative vote
- of seven (7) Councilors or alternatively enact the Chair's submitted signed Tribal Resolution
- 33 with the proposed budget by an affirmative majority vote of Tribal Council. In enacting the
- Chair's proposed budget, Tribal Council shall approve it as presented and shall not make any
- 35 changes, additions or deletions to the proposed budget.

7	Policy. Such policies shall include dates and deadlines for submissions, posting requirement
8	and the approval process.

10	<b>D.</b> Special Tribal Council or Committee meetings may be called for emergency funding
11	requests.

13	<b>E.</b> Any monies not expended during the fiscal year shall revert to General Fund Balance
14	funds.

16	CECTION VV. DUDGET MODIFICATIONS
17 18	SECTION XV. BUDGET MODIFICATIONS
19	<b>A.</b> No monies can be moved between two different revenue sources. Revenue sources are
20	General Funds, Cost Recovery, and Grant/Federal Contract Funds.
21	General Funds, Cost Recovery, and Grant/Federal Contract Funds.
22	<b>B.</b> Within a fiscal year, no more than 4% of the total amount of either budget can be moved
23	between two different departments or individual program not within a specific department a
24	listed on the approved Tribal-wide Budget Worksheet, without Tribal Council approval. Such
25	requests shall be posted for comment on the Tribal website for at least seven (7) days prior to
26	Tribal Council approval. Tribal Council shall act on the request within thirty (30) days o
27	receipt of the request.
28	
29	C. Operating Budget Modifications are the transfer of monies between line-items within
30	an individual fund within the same fiscal year are allowable, within the following criteria:
31	
32	1. Prior to approving any budget modification involving space costs, the CFO
33	shall ensure that all space costs are adequately funded.
34	

- 1 **D.** All budget modifications must be reviewed by the CFO to ensure that no material
- 2 change in an existing service or program is altered either in nature or scope. If there is a
- 3 material change in an existing service or program by either a change in the nature or scope of
- 4 the service or program, then the budget modification shall be submitted to Tribal Council for
- 5 approval.

### SECTION XVI. ADDITIONAL REVENUES

- 10 A. If actual revenues during a fiscal period exceed the projected revenues, the CFO, on a
- quarterly basis, will report to Tribal Council the amount of excess funds, the date of the receipt
- of the funds and the funding source.

- 14 **B.** If actual revenues during a fiscal period fall short of projected revenues, Tribal Council
- shall take necessary actions to ensure that funding for approved budgets is available by adding
- additional sources of revenue to the budget or shall declare a budget emergency.

#### SECTION XVII. EMERGENCY BUDGETS/RECISSIONS

A. At any time during the fiscal year the Treasury Office, based on a revenue analysis and other factors, may recommend to Tribal Council to declare a budget emergency.

- 24 **B.** If Tribal Council declares a budget emergency, Tribal Council shall provide guidance and criteria for amended budgets that must be submitted by the Governmental Branches within
- 26 the timeframe provided by Tribal Council. All amended budgets must be passed by Tribal
- 27 Resolution.

28

29 **C.** Upon the declaration of a budget emergency by Tribal Council, Tribal Council shall 30 take necessary steps to notify Tribal Citizens of the impact of the budget emergency.

#### SECTION XVIII. SYSTEMATIC REDUCTIONS OF BUDGETS
