34. Items relating to briefings

During the period under review, the Security Council received eight briefings that were not explicitly connected to any specific item on the agenda of the Council.

Among them, four meetings were held under the agenda item "Briefings by Chairs of subsidiary bodies of the Security Council", 1 at which the Chair of various sanctions and counter-terrorism committees and working groups provided an overview of the work of their organs to the Council, including the cooperation among the Committees in addressing the evolving threat posed by terrorism. 2

Two meetings were held under the agenda item "Briefing by the Chairperson-in-Office of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe", at which the Chairperson-in-Office of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) briefed the Council on the security priorities of the OSCE, its activities in de-escalating emerging crises and resolving protracted conflicts, and its collaborations with the United Nations, in particular, in combatting terrorism.

Two briefings were held in closed sessions by the President of the International Court of Justice.
